- Celebrates the date when slavery ended in America
 - June 19, 1865
- Became a Federal Holiday in 2021
- Added to the State Holiday schedule in 2022

JUNETEENTH HOLIDAY



Holidays. The employee shall have the state observed holidays set forth in Legal Holidays, Public Act 124 of 1865, being MCL 435.101, et seq. off with pay. This does not modify the "Rate of Pay" set forth in Subsection 3.1. All state observed holiday paid time off shall be observed on the date set forth in state law.
