CALLING SPECIAL MEETINGS



ORIGINAL LANGUAGE

Section 6.2.4: Special Meetings. Special Meetings of the Commission may be scheduled by majority vote of the Commission during a meeting or may be called by the Chairperson, Vice[1]Chairperson or the Executive Director with not less than an 5 (5) hour notice. The location of a special meeting shall be a place and time designated in the special meeting notice. All official actions taken at a Special Meeting shall have the same force and effect as those taken at a Regular Meeting of the Commission.

CALLING SPECIAL MEETINGS



PROPOSED LANGUAGE

Section 6.2.4: Special Meetings. Special Meetings of the Commission may be scheduled by majority vote of the Commission during a meeting or may be called by the Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, the Executive Director, **or two commissioners** with not less than an 5 (5) hour notice. The location of a special meeting shall be a place and time designated in the special meeting notice. All official actions taken at a Special Meeting shall have the same force and effect as those taken at a Regular Meeting of the Commission.
