- 1.) Please formally contact the MI Auditor General to request that he finishes the "Procedural Audit" that you formally requested to identify your "Rules of Procedure" and to ensure that you followed the approved procedures while executing the financial transactions (see meeting transcripts), including item #6133.2 on your current expense report where you paid money to clearly partisan Litigation Attorneys in direct contradiction to the MI Constitution (see meeting transcripts) and the appropriateness of approving a Motion to delegate unknown actions to the Executive Director in contradiction to Roberts Rules of Order 2020 (RRNR).
- 2.) I'm working with the MI Judicial Council and the MI Supreme Court to recommend that the Court issue an order to establish the current edition of RRNR as the "Fundamental Principles of Parliamentary Procedure in Michigan" and to create formal trainings for guidance in the field.
- 3.) I also submitted to the Justices copies of apparent anomalies in the MICRC applications of Commissioners Lett, Szatela, and Kellom that appear to be incomplete because in the space for an answer to required conflict of interest questions about Political Party Affiliation they stated that they 'choose not to answer' which is effectively an incomplete application in direct contradiction to MI Constitution.
- 4.) Also, it appears that the Roberts Rules of Order, Cheat Sheet for Nonprofits (from Board Effects) contained in your orientation materials may be maliciously misrepresenting RRNR which appears to constitute "MI Elections Misinformation and/or Disinformation".

 Please schedule a Special Meeting with a Public Hearing to review and amend MICRC's "Rules of Procedure" appropriately with the formal written advice of a Certified Professional Parliamentarian.
- 5.) Also, In my personal opinion it appears that Commissioner Witjes may be a "Hostel Foreign Actor" who has violated his "Oath of Office" for personally instilling components of "Deliberative Democracy" (Pounder Model, Netherlands, 1960's) into the proceedings of the MICRC in contradiction to our

"Constitutional Democracy" and RRNR.
