Title: Recognizing and Responding to Mental Health Concerns in the Home

Session Description: This workshop helps home visitors gain the essential skills to recognize and respond to mental health challenges within the home environment. Participants will learn to identify signs of mental distress, engage in sensitive conversations, and provide appropriate referrals to mental health professionals. The training emphasizes understanding the impact of mental health on parenting and family dynamics, promoting supportive interactions, and addressing personal biases. Through clinical examples, home visitors will build confidence in supporting families facing mental health issues. This session supports the following Michigan Home Visiting Core Knowledge Framework area: Family Mental Health

When: The training will take place from 9:00 am-10:30 am Eastern Time on Thursday, June 5, 2025.
