### May Coordinator Training 2024: Registration Open

We look forward to this year's annual MIHP May Coordinator Training and are pleased to announce that **registration has opened!**

MIHP providers are required to attend the MIHP Coordinator Meeting each year. These are annual opportunities to enhance knowledge and skills that can improve home visiting practices, obtain programmatic and department updates, and network with other MIHP providers.

The training is designed for the MIHP Coordinator, however another MIHP staff member may also attend as an agency representative. Agencies are limited to a total of **two** attendees. The only exception to this is that providers with multiple sites may have three attendees. The MIHP Coordinator is responsible for disseminating related information and training content to their MIHP staff.

Attending the closest location is recommended; however, an agency may register for any single location across the state.

Since distributing the "Save the Date" information in October, there has been an adjustment to some locations and dates due to the availability of space. We apologize if this has caused any inconvenience and appreciate your understanding.
