### Seeking Advisory Group Members

The Michigan Department of Health & Human Services Maternal Infant Health Program (MDHHS MIHP) and the University of Michigan Youth Policy Lab have partnered to develop new evidence-based intake and discharge documentation to replace the existing Risk Identifiers and Discharge Summaries. With an increased focus on health equity, MIHP is devoted to the inclusion of diverse perspectives and experiences. As such, MIHP is seeking individuals to participate in an upcoming series of advisory meetings to provide input on the development process.

As providers of MIHP services, agency-level input is an integral component of developing a quality product that will accurately capture the strengths, goals, and needs of participating families and identify opportunities for MIHP intervention. The new product aims to fulfill the administrative requirements of MIHP while being culturally responsive, inclusive, and respectful of beneficiaries' goals.
