## Maternal Infant Health Program Cycle 9 Protocols

There are a total of sixteen Cycle 9 protocols required for the Maternal Infant Health Program. Of the 16, two are new protocols and eight protocols from Cycle 8 require updates or revisions based on Cycle 9 guidance. The new protocols and the updates are highlighted for your convenience. Attached are the Cycle 9 Protocol Specifications accompanied by a required Protocol Signature document for submission.

Instructions for the Protocol Signature Document: Specify one of the following:

- If there is no change on a previously approved Cycle 8 protocol
- If there is an update for a previously approved Cycle 8 protocol, indicate the date the update was submitted to MDHHS MIHP
- Date a newly required protocol was sent to MDHHS MIHP

All new and revised Cycle 9 Protocols must be submitted via email to the [MDHHS-MIHP-CERT-REVIEW@michigan.gov](mailto:MDHHS-MIHP-CERT-REVIEW@michigan.gov) email where they will be reviewed and approved or returned for revisions. Protocols must be submitted no later than Monday, April 18, 2022, at 5:00 pm. MIHP Reviewers will respond within 21 business days with any revisions needed and (if necessary) agency staff must revise and resubmit within 5 business days. Protocols must be approved or final draft in process by June 1, 2022.

Note:

- Previously approved Cycle 8 protocols that do not require updates/revisions do not need to be submitted unless the agency has made revisions.
- Approved protocols are required for certification
