

Important MIHP Update- October 29, 2025



New Optional Plan of Safe Care Training Course

A new **optional training course** related to the **Plan of Safe Care (POSC)** is now available. This course has been developed and serves as a supplemental resource to **enhance understanding of how other systems approach POSC**, with the goal of strengthening and supporting **cross-system collaboration** and shared learning.

The **Plan of Safe Care Protocol Training** course can be accessed via the [miHealth Public Learning Management System \(LMS\)](#). This course is designed for all four systems involved in implementing Michigan's POSC Protocol: Child Welfare, Healthcare, Home Visiting, and Substance Use Treatment Providers.

The course is comprised of **three sections**, with each section offering **1.0 contact hours** for Continuing Education. Because this course provides continuing education credit, participants must view all content in its entirety to receive credit—skipping or fast-forwarding through content is not permitted.

For awareness, the course includes a clinical perspective that offers an in-depth look at best practices for screening, intervention, and treatment approaches applicable to all systems participating in the POSC initiative. The content is intended to foster a shared understanding of clinical considerations that influence the development and implementation of effective Plans of Safe Care.

MIHP staff are reminded that when **co-creating a Plan of Safe Care (POSC)** with a beneficiary, the [MIHP-specific template and guidelines](#) must be used, and all requirements outlined in the [MIHP Operations Guide](#) are to be followed.
