Description: This two-part training will introduce you to a new parent-child interaction guide along with strategies to strengthen your observations skills to support critical relationship-based attunement between infants, toddlers and the adults who care for them. Participants will learn together with peers, practice their observation skills using videos of Michigan families, and discuss how to use observations with families. Participants will also be provided with guidance on how to write a quality observation. **This is a free, virtual, two-part series. It is expected that participants attend both sessions.**
