### Training Opportunity from the Michigan Home Visiting Initiative

#### Substance Use Part 2: A Collaborative Approach to Supporting Families

*This information is being shared on behalf of the Michigan Home Visiting Initiative. Please share with home visitors who may be interested.*

This is the second session in a two-part series on this topic. If you missed the first session, there is a recording available that can be watched beforehand to prepare for this training. This session relies on knowledge from the first session along with your home visiting experiences. A recording of the first session will be emailed to you with your registration confirmation. The training will begin with a brief overview and key acknowledgements of the home visitor's role in this work. Following that, there will be an opportunity for networking and questions through case presentations. Prior to the training, participants will receive a form asking them to think about certain situations and submit the case presentations confidentially. The presenters will share insights and engage in conversations related to the identified situations.
