### 2025 May Coordinator Meeting Registration Open!

We look forward to this year's annual MIHP May Coordinator Meeting and are pleased to announce that **registration has opened!**

MIHP providers are required to attend the MIHP Coordinator Meeting each year. This is an annual opportunity to enhance knowledge and skills that can improve home visiting practices, obtain programmatic and department updates, and network with other MIHP providers.

The meeting is designed for the MIHP Coordinator, however another MIHP staff member may attend as an agency representative. Due to space accommodations, agencies are limited to a total of two attendees. The only exception is for providers with multiple sites. They may have three attendees. The MIHP Coordinator, and/or representative of the agency, is responsible for disseminating related information and content to their MIHP staff.

Attending the closest location is recommended; however, staff may register for any single location across the state. **Please note, you must register to attend. There will be no onsite registration.**
