WHAT CARE VISITS QUALIFY FOR FREE TRANSPORTATION?

- PRENATAL**
Healthcare appointments to help keep new mom and baby healthy during pregnancy
- POSTPARTUM**
Up to a year of rides to health care appointments following birth of their child
- PEDIATRIC**
Up to the baby's first birthday to help them stay healthy

Pregnant? New Mom? Caregiver? Get FREE ROUNDTRIP RIDES to doctor appointments!

When are free rides available?

- Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 6 p.m.
- Saturday, 8 a.m. – 2 p.m.
- Services are not available on holidays

How are free rides scheduled?

- Call 313-876-0000 to schedule a ride
- Allow enough time to get to the appointment on time
- Rides can be scheduled up to one hour before the appointment or a week in advance

All riders with children must bring their own car seat
