Save the Date: 2026 May MIHP Coordinator Meeting

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) Maternal Infant Health Program (MIHP) is pleased to share the upcoming **2026 May MIHP Coordinator Meeting dates**. This annual meeting is a required event for all MIHP Program Coordinators and continues to serve as an essential statewide forum for strengthening program knowledge, enhancing home visiting practices, reviewing policy and operational updates, and supporting consistency and quality across all MIHP provider agencies.

For 2026, the meeting will be held **virtually**. We recognize that, traditionally, this meeting has taken place in person, and we understand the value many providers place on in-person networking and connection. However, after reviewing the increased travel demands of each agency surrounding the upcoming 2026 Home Visiting Conference Model Day session, as well as the broader budget concerns that some agencies may be facing, MDHHS MIHP has determined that a virtual format will best support provider participation and minimize burden this year.

The meeting will be offered on two dates to accommodate prearranged schedules. Those dates are: **Thursday, May 14, 2026**, and **Tuesday, May 19, 2026**. **The same content will be presented on both days**, and each MIHP Coordinator or designee is required to attend **only one** of the two sessions. Each session will run from **10:00 AM to 2:30 PM**, including a lunch break from **12:00 PM to 12:30 PM**. Coordinators or their designee must attend the full session for certification requirements. The virtual opportunity will allow additional staff to attend as well. Each session will be capped at 150 participants, therefore when registration information is shared, please sign up as soon as possible.

Further information regarding the meeting will be shared closer to the event. Thank you for your ongoing dedication to the Maternal Infant Health Program and for your efforts to prepare for this important annual meeting.
