Clarification: Adding a POC 2

If a need is identified during a professional visit, you may address the need and document the identified domain in the "Other visit information" section of the *Professional Visit Progress Note* or *Contact Log*.

After the professional visit, conduct a case conference with both disciplines to add the appropriate *Plan of Care, Part Two* to the beneficiary's chart, and update the *Plan of Care, Part Three*.

At the next visit, any interventions regarding the added *Plan or Care, Part Two* must be documented in the "Domain" section on the *Professional Visit Progress Note*.
