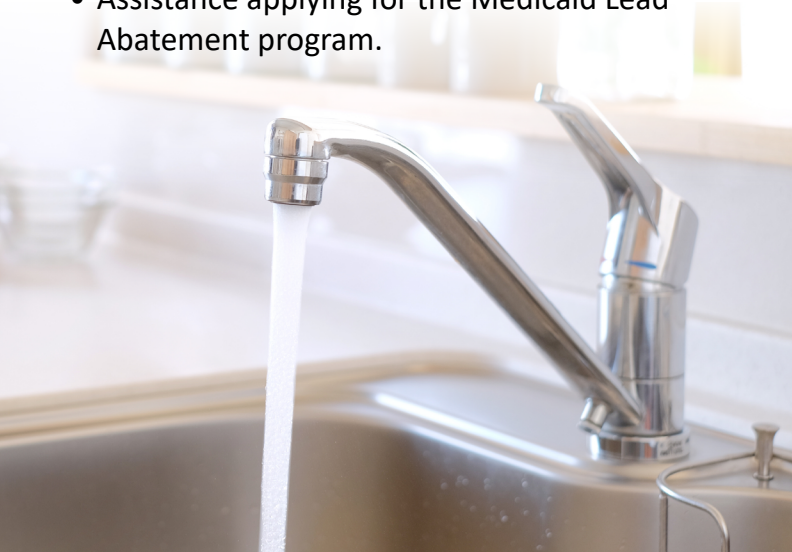

The Faucet & Filter Safety Net Program

can provide the following for eligible households:

- Lead-reducing filter.
- Replacement cartridges.
- A home visit and a visual plumbing assessment.
- A single faucet replacement.
- Assistance applying for the Medicaid Lead Abatement program.

To access available resources, households must meet the following criteria:

The home must be occupied by a child under 19 years of age enrolled in Medicaid, and/or a pregnant person enrolled in Medicaid.

AND

The home has, or unsure if it has, one of the following:

- Lead or galvanized plumbing.
- A lead service line carrying water from the street to the home.
- Old faucets and fittings that were sold before 2014.

AND

The home must be located within one of the following communities:

- City of Albion
- City of Benton Harbor
- City of Detroit
- City of Ecorse
- City of Flint
- City of Hamtramck
- City of Highland Park
- City of Inkster
- City of Muskegon Heights
- City of Pontiac
- City of Saginaw
