Section 32p(4) Home Visitation Data Collection

The Michigan Department of Lifelong Education, Advancement, and Potential (MiLEAP), is announcing Section 32p(4) Home Visitation Data Collection. The purpose of this effort is to collect updated data to inform future grant allocations with the end goal of serving more children and families. The current grant allocation was based on the original data collection in FY16 and may not reflect current need.

The updated data will be collected utilizing the [Exploration and Planning Tool](#). Developed in collaboration with the Michigan Public Health Institute as part of their on-going support and leadership in the Michigan Home Visitation Initiative (MHVI), this tool will provide updated information about the needs of families by individual community and collectively across the state.

Current grantees are required to complete and submit the Exploration and Planning Tool for FY25. Instructions for completing and submitting the Exploration and Planning tool will be provided to GSC Directors in June for the FY25 Section 32p(4) Home Visitation Grants. Incomplete Exploration and Planning tools will be returned for resubmission. Information received will be used to formulate grant allocations and inform future funding requests.

The 32p(4) Home Visitation Funds are awarded through ISDs as fiduciaries of their GSCs. Funding is provided for Intermediate School Districts (ISDs) or consortium of ISDs, as fiscal agents, to designate funds to implement home visits for families and their at-risk children birth through age five. Funds must support the implementation of home visitation services, based upon a locally coordinated, family-centered, and data-driven home visiting plan.
