 Early Education	<p>High-quality PreK program</p>	
 Family Support	<p>Family advocates help families reach their personal goals and parents and caregivers are valued as partners in their child's education</p>	<p>Strong parent/family involvement as partners in child's education</p>
 Food Service	<p>Free healthy meals and snacks provided</p>	
 Eligibility	<p>At 100% of Federal Poverty Level Snap Recipients</p>	<p>Open to all 4-year olds, prioritizing those who need it most.</p>

 Health & Wellness	<p>Free health screenings for children: Medical, Dental, Hearing, Vision services Health and mental health supports</p>	<p>Referral for Medical, Dental, Mental Health</p>
