

Don't Forget Your Pets!



Make sure your pets are prepared for disasters and emergencies too. Take simple steps now so they will be ready when disaster strikes.



1. Make a Plan

- ▶ Know what to do with your pet during an evacuation. Many public shelters and hotels do not allow pets inside. Know a safe place where you can take your pets before disasters and emergencies happen.
- ▶ Develop a buddy system. Plan with neighbors, friends or relatives to make sure that someone is available to care for or evacuate your pets if you are unable to do so.

2. Build a Kit

▶ Items to include:

- food and water (3 days)
- bowls
- can opener

- medications
- important documents
- first aid kit
- collar with ID tag
- harness

- leash
- bedding
- favorite toys
- treats
- photo for identification



3. Stay Informed

- ▶ Always bring your pets indoors at the first sign or warning of a storm.
- ▶ Stay informed of current conditions and know how you will receive emergency alerts and warnings.
