I am pleased to share with you what Student Scholarships, Grants and Outreach (SSGO), within the Michigan Department of Treasury – Office of Postsecondary Financial Planning, has accomplished during the 2021 fiscal year. The following report provides information about funds administered and the number of Michigan students awarded at each institution.

Our goal is always to enhance the customer service experience and to expand outreach resources to help Michigan students afford college. We focus efforts on working with high school counselors to encourage students to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and learn more about State financial aid program with an emphasis on the Tuition Incentive Program (TIP). Additionally, we work with participating institutions to identify students eligible for State financial aid in maximizing utilization.

The MiSSG data management system allows access to students, counselors, and financial aid administrators. Students can set up a portal account to view their award information in real-time. Counselors can easily identify which of their students need to file a FAFSA or view TIP eligible students. Colleges can view student awards and certify enrollment directly from MiSSG.

During Academic Year 2020-21, SSGO assisted 62,447 students with more than \$122 million in aid. These numbers reflect a drop in enrollment from the previous year as we continue to see the impacts of COVID-19*.

SSGO is continuing to focus on the customer service experience while supporting our students as they navigate their postsecondary options during these challenging times.

The funds paid for MCS awards exceeded the MCS appropriation. A total of 3,699 students were identified as dual eligible and received their MCS award at a private institution. A total of \$6,017,693.00 was paid through the MTG fund to supplement these MCS awards to the private institution maximum award.

DE received a supplement of \$400,000 to cover a shortfall.

CHILDREN OF VETERANS TUITION GRANT (CVTG)

The program provides undergraduate tuition assistance to certain children of qualified Michigan veterans who are permanently and totally disabled, MIA, or deceased. The renewable award pays a maximum of \$2,800 per academic year.




POLICE OFFICER'S AND FIRE FIGHTER'S SURVIVOR TUITION GRANT (STG)

The program provides a waiver of tuition at State public institutions of higher education for children and surviving spouses of Michigan police officers and fire fighters killed in the line of duty.




