I am pleased to share with you what Student Scholarships and Grants (SSG), within the Michigan Department of Treasury – Office of Postsecondary Financial Planning, has accomplished during the 2019 fiscal year. The following report provides information about funds administered and the number of Michigan students awarded at each institution.

Our goal is always to enhance the customer service experience and to expand resources to help Michigan students afford college. We focus efforts on working with high school counselors to encourage students to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and Tuition Incentive Program (TIP) application.

The MiSSG data management system allows for easy access for students, counselors, and financial aid administrators. Students can quickly set up a portal account where they can view their award information in real-time. Counselors can easily identify which of their students need to file a FAFSA or complete their TIP application. Colleges can view student awards and certify enrollment directly from MiSSG.

During Academic Year 2018-19, SSG assisted 71,012 students with more than \$125 million in aid.

SSG looks forward to continuing our focus on the customer service experience and working with students and parents regarding eligibility for State awards.

A Total of 5,444 students received their MCS award at a private institution, bringing \$5,051,758 in MCS dollars to the private institutions. In order for those 5,444 students to receive amounts equal to the Tuition Grants (\$2,400 max), the MCS awards (\$1,000 max), were supplemented with funds from the MTG fund. A total of \$6,980,783 was drawn from the MTG fund to supplement these MCS awards. The totals on this page do not match with the totals on page 18 because that shows the totals by award type.

CHILDREN OF VETERANS TUITION GRANT (CVTG)

The program provides undergraduate tuition assistance to certain children of qualified Michigan veterans who are permanently and totally disabled, MIA, or deceased. The renewable award pays a maximum of \$2,800 per academic year.








MCS Awards by Sector







The program provides a waiver of tuition at state public institutions of higher education for children and surviving spouses of Michigan police officers and fire fighters killed in the line of duty.





Total Funds Awarded, by Sector




Total Student Recipients, by Sector








