TUITION-FREE PATHWAY TO COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Michigan high school seniors and students who recently graduated from high school are eligible for the **Community College Guarantee** through the Michigan Achievement Scholarship, which includes:

- Earning a skills certificate or degree **tuition-free** at their in-district community college*.
 - In-district tuition, contact hours and mandatory fees are covered.
- An additional \$1,000 Michigan Achievement Bonus for Pell-eligible students to use toward additional college costs.

Eligibility Requirements

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Be a Michigan resident since July 1 of the previous calendar year.
- Graduate from a Michigan high school.
- There are no income requirements for the Community College Guarantee.

*Students would receive a significant tuition discount if they attend an out-of-district community college.
