

Description

Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Programs (GEAR UP) is a federal program designed to provide early intervention services and programs to students in middle school and high school. Each participating MI GEAR UP partner will be allotted a specific number of Michigan Education Trust (MET) and Student Scholarship, Grants and Outreach (SSGO) Educational Awards beginning with the high school Class of 2023. The highest ranked student will be awarded based on the number of awards available. Additional awards are available based upon funding and usage.

Application

MI GEAR UP does not require a specific application. However, students must file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). To check the status of an application, the student can log into the MiSSG Student Portal at michigan.gov/misssg.

Eligibility

To be eligible for an award, a student must:

- File a current-year Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Have successfully completed the MI GEAR UP program and been nominated to receive an award.
- Possess a high school diploma or recognized equivalent certificate.
- Initiate enrollment at a participating institution prior to age 22.
- Enroll at least half-time at an approved Michigan degree-granting college or university.
- Be a Michigan resident.
- If a dependent student, parent must also be a Michigan resident.
- Be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, or approved refugee.
- Not be in default on a Federal student loan.
- For renewal, meet institution's Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy.

Program Limits

Awards pay up to a maximum of \$2,000 per academic year at participating institutions. MI GEAR UP is not tuition-specific and may not exceed the student's Cost of Attendance (COA). Other gift aid may reduce or cancel this award. Future awards are subject to available and approved funding.

A student is no longer eligible to receive MI GEAR UP if:

- The student has received a MI GEAR UP award in two different academic years; or,
- The student has received \$4,000 in MI GEAR UP awards; or,
- Four calendar years have elapsed since high school graduation.
