

FELLOWSHIP



The MI Future Educator Fellowship offers a \$10,000 scholarship up to 2,500 future educators every year.

Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible, the student must:

- File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Be a high school graduate.
- Be admitted in an eligible Educator Preparation Program (EPP).
- Be working on your first teacher certification.
- Be enrolled in enough coursework to be considered enrolled full-time during the academic year, or
- its equivalency for individuals enrolled in an alternative certification program.
- Be at least a Junior Level student
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
- Be a Michigan resident since July 1 of the previous calendar year.
 - If you are a dependent student, your parent on your FAFSA must also be a Michigan resident since July 1 of the previous calendar year.

When a student receives the MI Future Educator Fellowship, they agree to teach in Michigan for a specific number of years.

Number of Academic Years Fellowship Received	Recipient Agrees to Teach in Michigan For
One	Three Years
Two	Four Years
Three	Five Years

If a student does not meet this service obligation requirement and/or does not finish the teacher certification program, the fellowship converts to a 0% interest rate loan with a repayment term of 10 years.
