



MI FUTURE EDUCATOR STIPEND



The MI Future Educator Stipend is a \$9,600 stipend per semester toward student teaching expenses to support Michigan's hardworking student teachers as they continue their journey to being in the classroom full-time.

Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible, the student must:

- Be admitted in an eligible Educator Preparation Program (EPP) approved by Michigan's State Board of Education.
- Be working towards teacher certification.
- Be participating full-time in a required student teaching experience, meeting one of the following parameters:
 - Full-time enrollment in required student teaching coursework.
 - 300 or more student contact hours while student teaching.
- Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).
- Not be employed by the district as a teacher of record.
- Not received the MI Future Educator Stipend before, unless your program specifically requires more than one semester of student teaching.
