
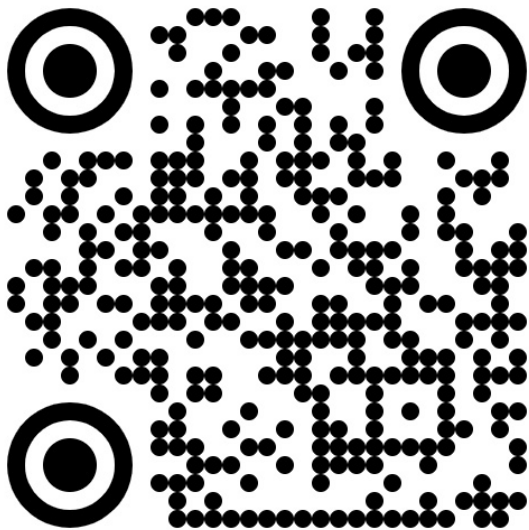

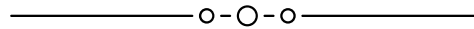

WHAT IS THE MITW?

The Michigan Indian Tuition Waiver (MITW), enacted by Public Act 174 of 1976, waives the tuition costs for eligible Native American students in public community colleges or universities within Michigan.



Students must be a Michigan resident and have resided in Michigan for at least 12 consecutive months at the time of application; must qualify for admission at a public institution in Michigan; and must be one-quarter (1/4) Native American blood quantum AND an enrolled citizen of a U.S. Federally recognized tribe.
