## Low Carbon EIED Grant Application Process Guide

The Low Carbon EIED Grant Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued on September 30, 2022. The RFP is posted to the grant webpage, along with other helpful information.

This document was developed as a guide for potential applicants. It includes a timeline for key tasks related to the application process. After posting of the RFP, there will be two opportunities for potential applicants to submit clarifying questions on the RFP.

Applicants should submit their proposals via the Low Carbon EIED Grant email address: <u>LARA-MPSC-LowCarbonGrants@michigan.gov</u></u>. Per Public Acts <u>53</u> and <u>166</u> of 2022, there is a public review period of 45 days. All proposals will be posted on the grants webpage by the date listed below. Local units of government, environmental groups, and business interests directly affected by the proposal will be able to submit comments through the grant webpage. After the 45-day review period ends, the applicants will have a 15-day window to modify their proposal and resubmit if desired. Modified proposals should also be submitted to <u>LARA-MPSC-LowCarbonGrants@michigan.gov</u> and the email should explain that the proposal has been modified. Modified proposals will be posted to the grant webpage.
