



Application Overview

MPSC Case No. U-21990

A Utility's Obligation and the Commission's Authority

- ❑ Utilities have an obligation to serve customers.
 - Applies to both existing and new customers
- ❑ The Commission approves the terms and conditions of service, including the rates charged to customers.
 - Utility Tariffs
 - Special Contracts
- ❑ Laws, Commission Rules, and the utility tariff govern how the utility fulfills its obligation to serve its customers.

DTE's Request: The Primary Supply Agreement

- ❑ Primary Supply Agreement (PSA)
 - Customer will take service under existing D11 Rate
 - ❑ Contribution to fixed system costs
 - ❑ Contribution to transmission costs and renewable energy costs through PSCR charges
 - Protections for other customers included in PSA that go beyond the terms of the D11 Tariff:
 - ❑ Contract duration – 19 years; 2 optional 10-year extensions
 - ❑ Minimum billing demand – 80% of the contract capacity
 - ❑ Termination payment – recovery of at least 10 years of minimum charges
 - ❑ Credit and collateral requirements – parent guaranty and letter of credit

DTE's Request: The Energy Storage Agreement

❑ Energy Storage Agreement (ESA)

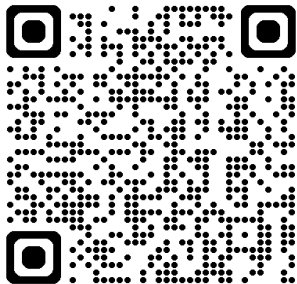
- Customer to pay for actual costs associated with 1.4 GW of energy storage over the associated 15-year recovery period.
 - ❑ Reconciled costs to be reviewed in rate cases
 - ❑ Termination payment = unrecovered portion of 15-year revenue requirement.
 - ❑ Credit and collateral requirements – parent guaranty and letter of credit
- Customer will receive the full value of market revenues provided by the energy storage assets, and DTE maintains full ownership and control of the storage assets.
- Stipulates that costs of the 1.4 GW of energy storage will not be passed on to other customers.

Consideration Framework

- ❑ Ex parte review of special contracts is appropriate only if approval will not impact existing rates or increase the cost of service for existing customers.
- ❑ To approve a proposed contract, the Commission must find that the contract is reasonable and in the public interest.

The Commission's authority and other reviews

- ❑ The Commission's authority:
 - Rates and provision of utility service
- ❑ Not within the Commission's authority:
 - Siting (local government)
 - Construction permits (local government)
 - Water, wetlands, and air quality concerns (MI Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy)
- ❑ Wetlands permit application public comment information
 - Public comment period is open through December 28
 - Public hearing on December 18 from 6:00 – 9:00 PM via zoom
