

# Superior Watershed Partnership

## 2024 MEAP Grant

**Grant Award:** \$2,460,000

**Service Area for all MEAP services:** Upper Peninsula of Michigan Upper Peninsula counties including: Alger, Baraga, Chippewa, Delta, Dickinson, Gogebic, Houghton, Iron, Keweenaw, Luce, Mackinac, Marquette, Menominee, Ontonagon and Schoolcraft.

**Anticipated Reach:** 1,300 Households

The Superior Watershed Partnership (SWP) is an MDHHS Navigation and Referral Partner for the Michigan Energy Assistance Program (MEAP). Households who present with an energy crisis will initially apply for the State Emergency Relief (SER) program, either directly with the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) or with assistance from the SWP MEAP or its program partners. SER applicants will be eligible to receive energy security services, including case management, energy conservation and budgeting workshop, referrals, energy kits, energy action plans, Department of Energy Home Energy Scores, weatherization and residential solar installation through the SWP MEAP. Qualified households will be eligible for SWP MEAP direct payment assistance, including enrollment in an affordable payment plan.

The SWP will assist clients in completing the MI Bridges application in person at the SWP Energy & Climate Office and at program partner locations.

This program will help struggling families in the Upper Peninsula of Michigan pay energy bills during the coldest months of the year, become more aware of home energy conservation and budgeting, receive the tools needed to gain the confidence to budget for future energy cost, and reduce energy consumption to decrease the household's dependence on LIHEAP.

### Program Details

- SWP and its program partners assist clients with the MI Bridges State Emergency Relief (SER) application
- Client completes required Energy-Security Plan to qualify for MEAP energy assistance
- Client completes required Energy Conservation and Financial Education workshops offered in-person, on paper and online; 50 clients will receive a home energy kit
- Affordable Payment Plans: DTE Energy, SEMCO Energy and Upper Peninsula Power Company
- Department of Energy Home Energy Score assessment including energy report and energy kit for up to 108 income-eligible MEAP clients
- Customized weatherization for up to 61 income-eligible MEAP clients
- Residential solar array panel installations for up to three income-eligible MEAP clients
