Thank you so much for helping to pull this together and for the follow-up from the stakeholder webinar earlier this week.

My only question/comment about the study is how to address the last point of the study's legislative mandate: "Identify barriers to developing and utilizing RNG in Michigan"

While the draft study outline includes a fairly robust final section dealing with this topic, the ICF presentation led me to believe that their work will be primarily technical- and economic-focused in nature, and that there may be a resulting gap when it comes to the Regulatory and Policy Opportunities.

I don't know if the MPSC intended for this topic to be handled through a parallel stakeholder-driven workgroup instead of addressed by ICF. However, based on Monday's presentation and discussion, I believe the MPSC may have to consider to what extent and how to address these topics.
