- 5/20/20 Staff updates on reporting to include arrearage data by customers and amounts
- 10/10/20 Monthly reporting on shut-offs, restorations, payment plans and arrearages.
- 6/30/21 Public Data Site is live. Data which was previously only available on the docket by an individual utility is now presented in a more easily analyzable format on the MPSC website.
