#### Scenario #1

- Decline in CO<sub>2</sub> emissions
- Modest EV growth
- Modest advancements toward electrification

#### **Scenario #1 Sensitivities**

- High fuel costs
- High load projections
- 2% EWR savings

#### Scenario #2

- Significant electrification advancements
- High load growth to support electrification
- Achievement of all announced CO<sub>2</sub> reductions.

#### **Scenario #2 Sensitivities**

- High and Low fuel cost
- All coal facilities are closed by 2030
- 2.5% EWR savings






