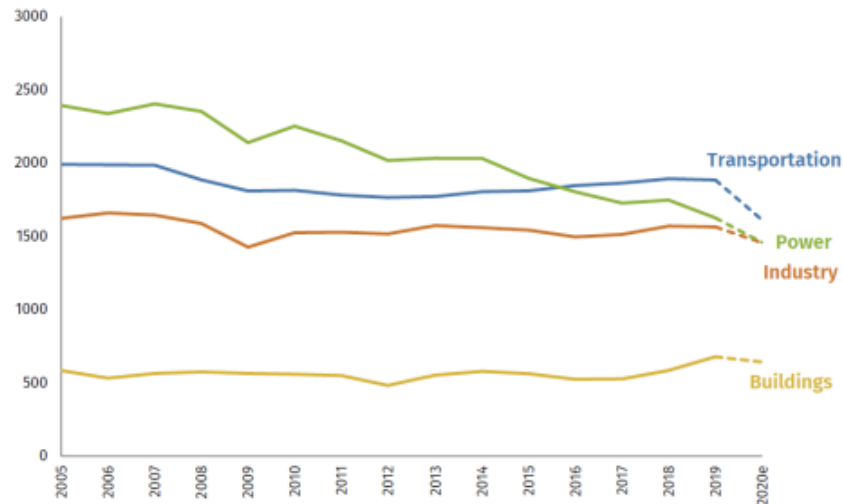

MI Healthy Climate Plan

The MI Health Climate Plan Key Goals Related to IRP's

- Close all coal electric generation facilities by 2030.
- Reach 50% energy from renewable resources by 2030 with 10% coming from other renewable resources.
- 50% of vehicle sales are electric vehicles by 2030.
- EWR savings equals 2% energy sales annually.

The Commission has directed Staff to file the following:

- 1) MIRPP Final Draft in **U-21219** on **June 30**
- 2) Filing Requirements Final Draft in **U-18461** on **June 30**

The Commission is expected to kick off the **120-day** process for the MIRPP per MCL 460.6t(1) in **U-21219** sometime after Staff's filing which will include a comment period.

The Commission is expected to request comments on the Draft Filing Requirements in **U-18461**.
