INCIDENT TACTICAL DISPATCHER (INTD) May 1 - May 5, 2023 Harrison (Clare), Michigan

An Incident Tactical Dispatcher is an experienced Public Safety Telecommunicator (PST) specially trained to operate in a command post, base camp, or at the incident scene. Attendees participate with hands-on training activities and in an exercise on the final day of the course. Incident Tactical Dispatchers leverage the multi -tasking, communication, accountability and documentation skills of successful PSTs to provide public safety communications expertise and support at planned events and extended incidents. This course provides a basic understanding for the roles and responsibilities of an incident tactical dispatcher working in a tactical environment.
