This is a 4-day course beginning at noon on Monday, April 10 and ending by noon on Friday, April 14, 2023

There is no fee to attend. Students will need a device to download class materials and use during the course.

The requirement to access broadband data during incidents or events has increased exponentially in recent years. This has spurred the need for personnel with highly specialized knowledge and expertise to be included in the ICS during planned events and incidents. In 2018 and 2019, CISA introduced the ITSL course to establish the best way to integrate the ITSL into the ICS. The ITSL provides information management, cybersecurity, and application management for critical incidents and events.

- Awareness of public safety broadband and wireless communication technologies.
