
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# Lead PIOs for State of Michigan During Disasters and Emergencies

- Lead and coordinate SEOC and state agency messaging through the Joint Information Center (JIC) during State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) activations.
- Preparedness, Response, Recovery

- Infrastructure Failure




# Northern Michigan Ice Storm Spring 2026

- Public Information Efforts:
  - Centralized disaster webpage
  - 350+ coordinated social posts
  - 60+ news releases
  - Unified state/local messaging
  - Local agency PIO coordination



# Incident Command System: PIO

- Member of Command Staff
- Advises Incident Commander
- Manages public information
- Leads the Joint Information Center (JIC)
- Coordinates messaging across agencies



# The Joint Information System

- Framework for coordinated communication
- Enables multiple agencies to speak with one voice
- Central hub for messaging collaboration



# Purpose of the JIC

The JIC ensures the response speaks with one coordinated, unified voice while supporting Command and protecting operational integrity.



- Centralizes public information functions in one coordinated location
- Supports the Incident Commander through the PIO
- Ensures unified, consistent messaging across all responding agencies
- Delivers timely, accurate information to the public and media
- Monitors and corrects misinformation to maintain public trust

# One Unified Voice Saves Time, Reduces Risk, Builds Trust

Interoperability is no longer just about radios.  
It's about coordinated information, shared awareness,  
and delivering clear, timely guidance to the public.



# What is Interoperability?



The ability of multiple agencies, systems, and personnel to communicate, share information, and operate together effectively during an incident.

# PIO Role in Information Interoperability

- Ensures consistent messaging
- Shares verified information
- Aligns communication between partners
- Prevents conflicting public statements
- Manages outward facing response
- Maintains incident narrative and ground truth
- Addresses rumors and misinformation

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# Internal vs External Interoperability

- Internal: coordination among agencies
- External: communication with the public, media, and stakeholders



# Quick, accurate communication impacts public safety and builds trust.




Goal: Get the right information to the right people at the right time so they can make the right decision.



Today, information spreads instantly. Not just on social media, but among family and friends.

The faster you get out in front, the easier it is to set the tone, build awareness, and maintain public trust.

A poor public information response can cast a shadow of doubt on even the best emergency response.



# A Hard Truth

- Radio traffic is not private
- Social media
- Scanners and apps
- Scanners going encrypted
  - New Federal Privacy Policy
  - Agencies in Michigan: Oct. 2026
  - Media fighting policy
- Public Alerts
  - Can make own news
  - Mis-information
  - Bad test messages



# Michigan State University Campus Shooting, February 13, 2023

- Gunman opens fire in two buildings
- Three students killed; 5 others injured
- Unprecedented multi-agency response
- More than 2,200 911 calls
- 240+ text messages to 911
- 20+ dispatchers respond
- Response broadcast live around the world through scanner app
- News story based on dispatch, scanner, and radio traffic




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# 911 Calls Reveal New Details After 2 Bodies Discovered At Lake Overholser

- Two bodies recovered from a metro Oklahoma City lake days apart in March 2019
  - Adult
  - 6-year-old boy
- Police and 911 callers declined an on-camera interview
- Medical examiners report not yet released



911 OP: Are you sure it's a dead body?

CALLER: Yes ma'am. You can see the head and the ears.
