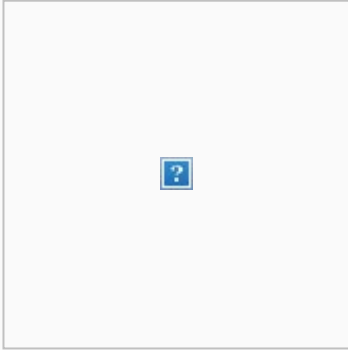

FY2022-2023 ESG Application Document Release

As the first step in the 2022-2023 fiscal year ESG (Emergency Solutions Grant) application process, MSHDA released the Exhibit 1 ahead of the NOFA (Notice of Funding Availability), application, and other supporting documents. This is change in process from previous application rounds is intentional as part of the strategic planning for each CoC (Continuum of Care) leading up to the ESG funding application.

Today, MSHDA releases the following documents for the FY22-23 ESG application round. All items will be posted to the [MSHDA ESG website](#) next week. Please note: Unlike this year's Exhibit 1, applications are required from each local planning body of the

Balance of State CoC as well as all other CoCs.

Exhibit 1 Update and Deadline Reminder

Clarification regarding the Racial Demographics report –

We've received questions regarding the scope of the required Racial Demographics report from the Michigan HMIS Data Warehouse. This report should cover each project type for the entire CoC, *regardless of funding source*. Please see the [detailed directions](#) below and contact your MSHDA Homeless Assistance Specialist with any additional questions.

1. After logging into the Michigan HMIS Data Warehouse, (<https://michigan-warehouse.openpath.host>) go to Reports > Operational > Core Demographics
2. Under General, set "Population by Project Type" to include: "PH, PSH & RRH", "ES", "TH", "SH", "SO" and "Homeless Prevention".
3. Under Reporting Period, select the Start date as being Oct 1, 2020. Set the End date as being Sep 30, 2021
4. Under CoC Codes and Funding, set the "CoC Code" to match that of your CoC.

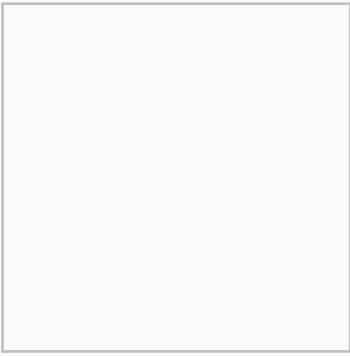
