SUBJECT: Social Security and Supplemental Income Benefits – Increased 8.7% for 2023

The Social Security Administration has announced that monthly Social Security and Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits will increase 8.7% in 2023. The increased amounts must be taken into consideration for all Tenant Income Certifications completed (signed) October 25, 2022, and thereafter.
