Do You Need Assistance Paying Your Rent?

The Housing Choice Voucher Program (HCV), administered by the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA), may be able to assist. The HCV Project Based Voucher program (PBV) is a federally funded rental subsidy program that may assist persons living at Dr. Maya Angelou Village with paying their rent.

MSHDA's HCV/PBV Program is partnering with Full Circle Communities, KMG Prestige, Inc., Homeless Action Network of Detroit, MiSide, Alternatives For Girls and RPI Management, Inc. to make available supportive housing units with rental subsidies for 23 (twenty-three) units (19-1BR, 3-2BR, 1-3/BR) located at 16711 Burt Road, Detroit, MI 48219

The PBV waiting list will be established by MSHDA beginning **Thursday, May 9, 2024**. The waiting list for the PBV rental assistance program will remain open indefinitely.

You may qualify for assistance at Dr. Maya Angelou Village, if your household income falls within the MSHDA allowable extremely low income for your family size, you meet program requirements and at least one of the following Supportive Housing Categories:

- Chronically Homeless
- Homeless Categories 1 or 4 (literally homeless or fleeing domestic violence)
- Highly Vulnerable Prioritized Population – Top 10% most in need

Staff at Alternatives For Girls will accept applications beginning **Thursday, May 9, 2024**. Please call **313-288-8025 between the hours of 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. Monday thru Friday** to inquire about your eligibility for placement on the PBV waiting list for rental assistance.

NOTE: Proof of legal identity (birth certificate) and proof of a valid Social Security number will be required for all members of the household.
