



Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Program Mobility Pilot NOFA Frequently Asked Questions 5-31-23

Will Mobility services/benefits from this pilot be made available to just *MSHDA's* Housing Choice Voucher holders in the counties chosen for the pilot (and not ALL HCV households with other PHAs)?

MSHDA's HCV Mobility Program is only available for eligible MSHDA HCV participants living in the counties chosen for the pilot.

Can both for-profit and non-profit entities apply?

Yes, applications will be accepted from both for-profit and non-profit entities.

Can agencies apply together as partners?

Agencies may apply together as partners. When doing so, the application must identify the Lead Agency as this is the agency that MSHDA will award the mobility service funding to, if the application is selected for the pilot.

Does the NOFA require the Continuum of Care (CoC) to prioritize one grantee for the application?

No, the HCV Mobility Pilot does not require that the CoC prioritize a specific agency/grantee for this funding opportunity.

Are the grantees required to have an active SAM registration?

Yes, all Fiscal Recovery Funds (FRF) grantees must be registered on: <https://sam.gov/content/home> and maintain an active registration status and Unique Entity Identifier.
