- Signage stripped and reprinted to customer specifications

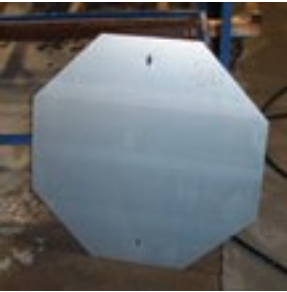
Option #3) Blank Returns Only:

Conserve our natural resources by restoring old signage

TURN OLD SIGNS INTO NEW SIGNS WITH "GREEN" SIGN RESTORATION

Michigan State Industries' sign shop understands that our communities are experiencing difficult economic times. You may be faced with the dilemma of needing to replace old signs, but not having the funds available in your budget. As a standard practice, when those reflective aluminum street and highway signs hit the end of their useful lives, they are destined for the landfill or sold for scrap. Michigan State Industries has the ability to strip your old, but usable, discolored or faded signs.



By utilizing skilled labor, MSI's "GREEN" Sign Restoration process applies heat that removes worn out reflective sheeting material from old signs without damaging the corrosion-resistant coatings on the metal. The signs are manually peeled and scraped, cleaned, and a chemical process is used to clean the blank. New reflective sheeting materials are applied, providing motorist more notice and increased safety.
