

# Michigan Volunteer Registry

## Overview

The Bureau of Emergency Preparedness, EMS, and Systems of Care (BEPESoC) leads the coordination, planning, implementation, and recruitment efforts of the Michigan Volunteer Registry (MVR). The MVR is an internet-based system that conforms to the Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response (ASPR), Emergency System for the Advanced Registration of Volunteer Health Professionals (ESAR-VHP) national standards and definitions.

The MVR provides a secure electronic database for Michigan residents and those who work in Michigan to express an interest in emergency response volunteerism, and for the State to quickly verify volunteer certifications and licenses prior to deployment. Registration is open to both medical and non-medical professionals with all skill levels and experiences who are willing to respond in the event of an emergency. Volunteers are also afforded the opportunity to participate in local, regional and state exercises, drills, trainings, educations, and volunteer recognition events.
