Officers interested in joining WCC are encouraged to apply for the WCC [Foundation Scholarship](#), designed to help remove financial barriers to students' success. Students must submit documentation of successful completion of MCOLES or police academy training to receive credits towards degree. Additional credits may be awarded for prior college or job experience. You can request credit for job experience by [Portfolio Evaluation](#). There is a \$50 application fee and you will be charged \$50 per credit hour awarded.
