



## LAW ENFORCEMENT INFORMATION NETWORK FBI Universal Control Numbers

This correspondence is being distributed to authorized Law Enforcement Information Network (LEIN) user agencies regarding a change to the Michigan Criminal History Record response via the LEIN.

Historically, the Interstate Identification Index (III) has used FBI Numbers (FNU) to index a subject's criminal history record. However, in the FBI's Next Generation Identification (NGI) system, subjects are indexed using fingerprint-based identities referenced by an FBI Universal Control Number (UCN). The FBI UCN is compatible with, but distinguishable from, an FNU. The FBI plans to implement this change on July 9, 2015.

To accommodate the change from FNU to UCN, on May 13, 2015, the Michigan Criminal History Record (CHR) System implemented a programming change. In lieu of the "FBI" label, Michigan CHR responses now display the label "UCN."

Below is an example response:
