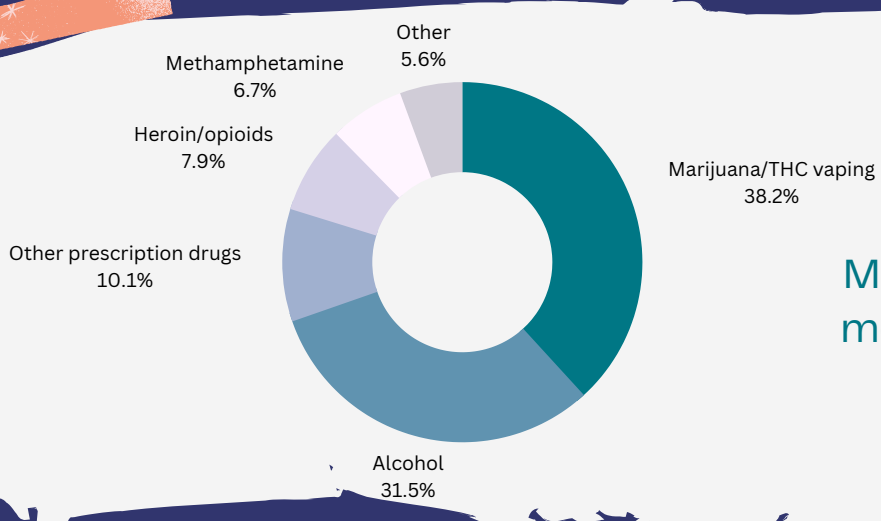


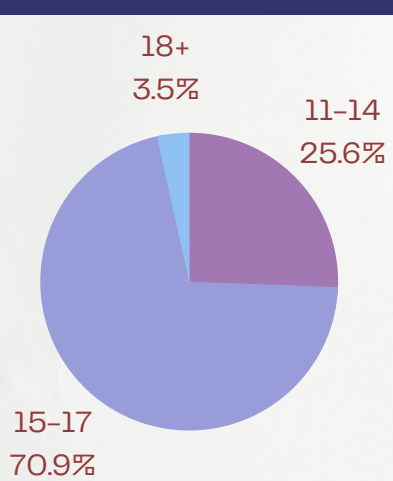

Kalkaska High School students report on how substance misuse affects their lives

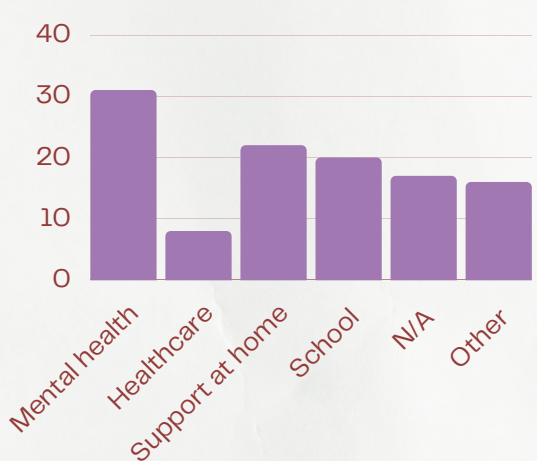
86 youth surveyed

Most respondents were aged 15-17

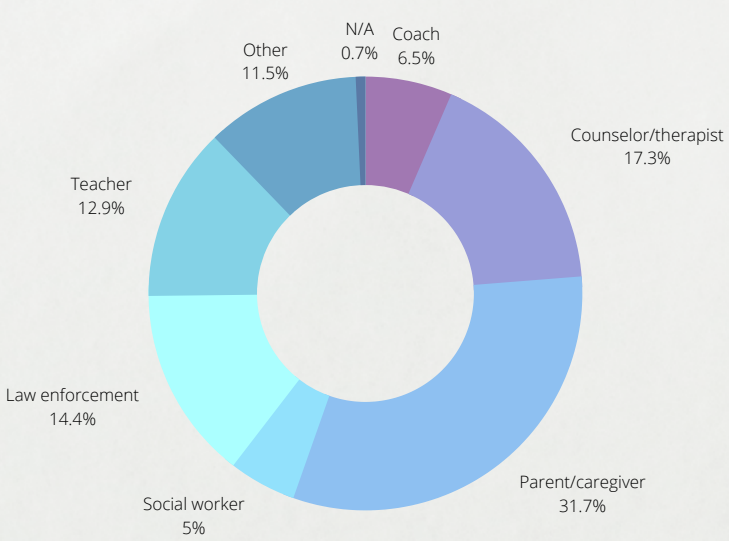


Supports needed

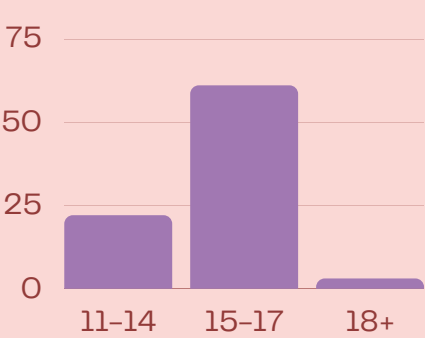

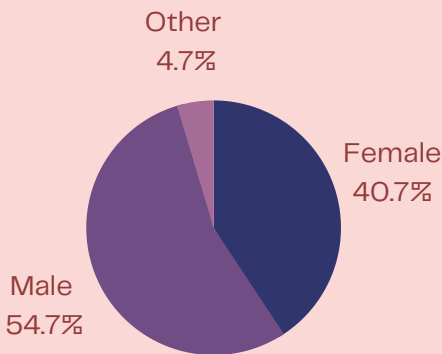

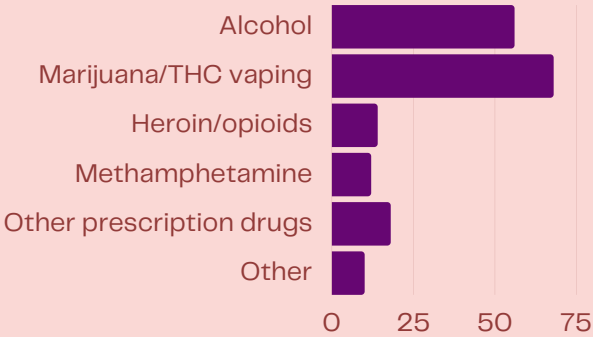

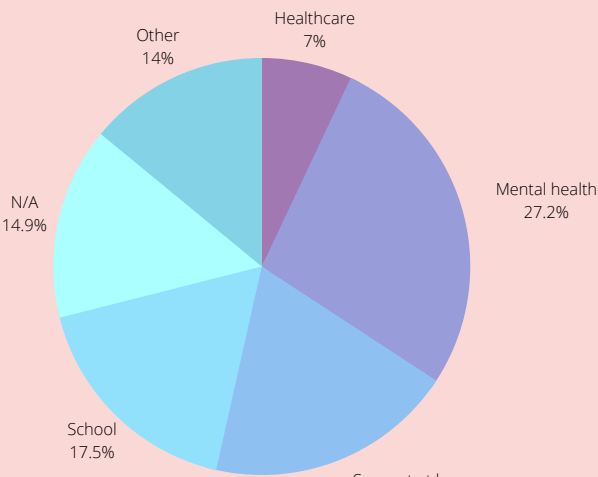
Age categories of respondents



Gender of respondents



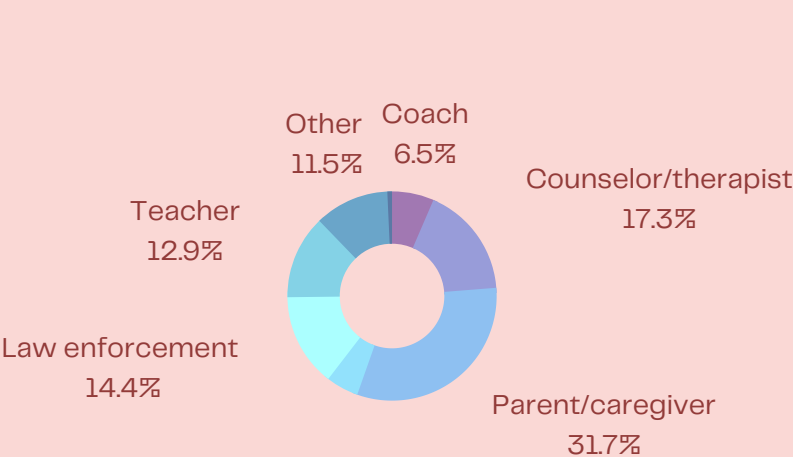
Substances most prevalently affecting respondents communities



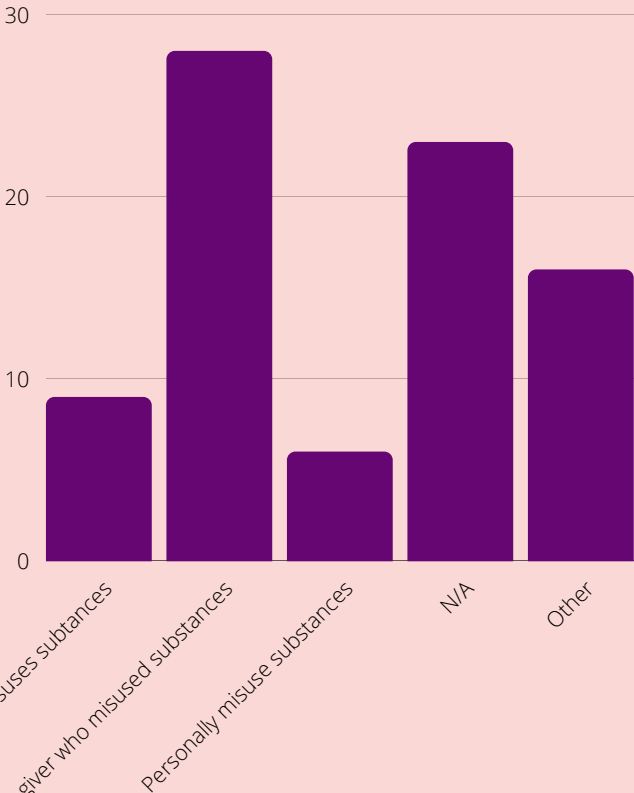
Supports youth need
