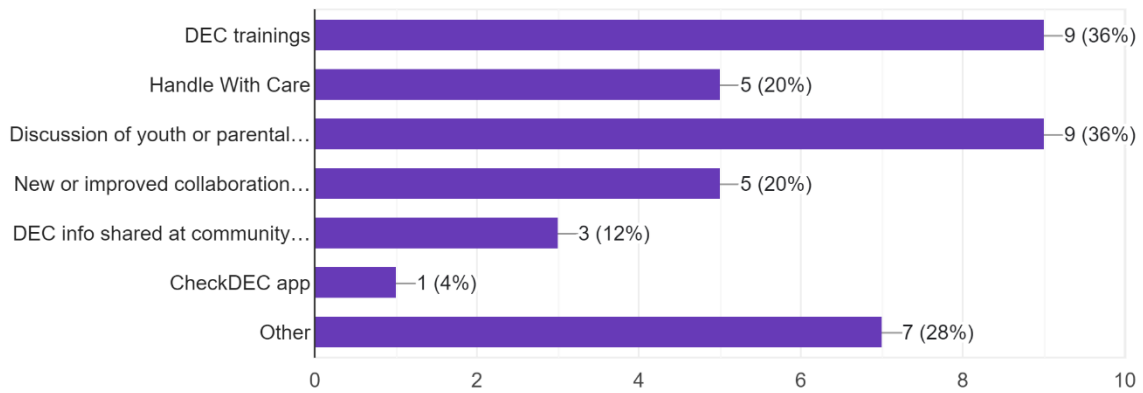
Have you participated in CORE DEC Awareness and DEC Approach training?

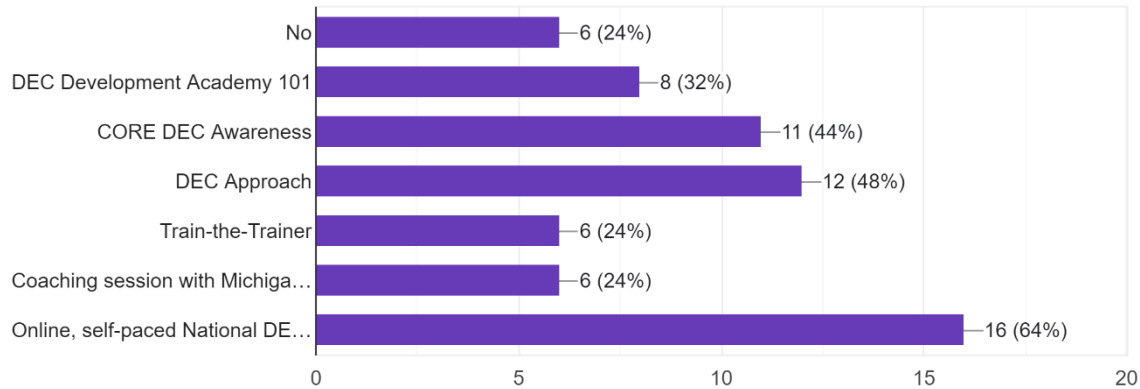
What DEC efforts are happening in your community? Please check all that apply.
