SIGNED INTO LAW:

HB 5701... PA 48 of 2022

Allows temporary door barricade devices in school buildings and provides standards.
Amends sec. 1d of 1937 PA 306 (MCL 388.851d).
Signed: March 23, 2022, Effective: March 23, 2022

HB 4698... PA 155 of 2022

Penalties for falsely pulling an active shooter alarm in a public place.
Amends 1931 PA 328 (MCL 750.1 - 750.568) by adding sec. 499. Signed
7/19/22; Effective 10/17/22

HB 4074... PA 24 of 2022

Encourages a program of instruction in free enterprise and entrepreneurship in school districts
and public school academies in social studies curriculum.
Amends 1976 PA 451 (MCL 380.1 - 380.1852) by adding sec. 1166b. Filed:
April 1, 2022, Effective: June 29, 2022

HB 4953... PA 88 of 2022

Requires the department of education to develop & update informational packet & provide to
school districts, intermediate school districts, public school academies, and nonpublic schools
(beginning 8/1/23). Packet to include certain information regarding postsecondary education,
AP, college level exam programs, tuition at university/college, loan info, vocational training
opportunities, etc.
Amends 1976 PA 451 (MCL 380.1 - 380.1852) by adding sec. 1293. Signed
5/26/22; Effective 8/23/22

HB 5190 ... PA 105 of 2022

Modifies requirements for Michigan merit curriculum to obtain HS diploma (namely, a course in
personal finance for those entering grade 8 in 2023)
Amends secs. 1278a & 1278b of 1976 PA 451 (MCL 380.1278a & 380.1278b). Signed:
June 16, 2022, Effective: September 13, 2022

SB 845 ... PA 144 of 2022 ...

FY 2022-23 Education Omnibus Appropriation Bill

- Over \$22bb
- 2022-2023: \$168mm (\$150mm State School Aid Fund + \$18mm GF) for payments to
districts & nonpublic schools for activities to improve student safety (non-competitive;
administered by MDE). Sec. 97.
- 2022-2023: \$25mm to fund at least one SRO (State School Aid Fund). Sec. 97b. o
Administered by MSP/GCSD

- 2022-23: \$15mm for pilot program to implement cross-system intervention approach for MS/HS students at risk of violence (public research institution w/in public university in MI). Sec. 97f.

Signed 7/14/22; immediate effect

HB 6012 (PA 093) appropriated \$12.5 million dollars for critical incident mapping / HB 6042

MOVING LEGISLATION:

HB 6042... School Safety Respond Plan

Lists requirements for critical incident mapping data in school safety respond plan (software compatible, printable format, accuracy verified, oriented true north... accurate floor plans; room labels, hallway names; door/stairwell numbers; etc.).

4/14/22: introduced; to Gov Ops

6/7/22: Sub (H-1) passed House 107-0 (3NV)

LEGISLATION TO WATCH:

SB 789

Require school personnel to immediately report to law enforcement an actual or implied threat.

Amends sec. 1308 of 1976 PA 451 (MCL 380.1308) & adds sec. 1308c.

12/14/21: Introduced; to Education and Career Readiness

SB 867 Door Barricade Devices

Modifies standards for temporary door barricade devices in school buildings.

2/29/22: Introduced; To Education and Career Readiness Committee

HB 6076-6077

6077 would require continuing education for mandated reporters of child abuse/neglect (once every 3 years as most recently drafted)

5/5/22: introduced; to Families, Children, and Seniors

RECENTLY INTRODUCED:

“School Safety Package,” HB 6319-6333

Frequency of safety drills (fire, tornado, lockdown);

Inclusion of the OK2Say phone number on ID badges;

Mandates for training for all SROs, school security personnel, and school staff; School Safety and Mental Health Commission within MDE.

Introduced: 6/30/22; to Rules and Competitiveness

HB 6151-6152

Allow teachers and other school employees to store tasers and firearms in school and on school property under certain circumstances.

5/26/22: Introduced; To Judiciary Committee

SB 1053 School Safety

Provide reporting by school safety commission to the legislature related to school safety.

5/19/22: Introduced; to Education and Career Readiness Committee
