



**DEFINITION**

Michigan collects the crime data for this offense based on the FBI NIBRS (National Incident Based Reporting System). This offense is defined as the sexual intercourse of a person, forcibly and/or against that person's will; or, not forcibly or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity.

**ANALYSIS**

**VOLUME**

The number of victims reported for CSC - 1st Degree, Sexual Penetration - Penis/Vagina was 3,290. This is a reported decrease of 6 percent from 2010 and a 9.9 percent decrease since 2007.

There were more victims in the month of January. February reported fewer victims.

**RATE**

The crime rate for this offense was 33.3 for every 100,000 persons. In 2010, the crime rate was 35.4, a decrease of 5.9 percent.

**CLEARANCES**

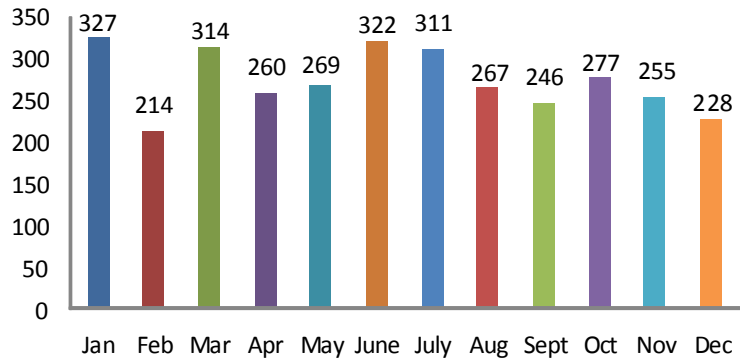
Law enforcement agencies cleared 737 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance. This is a reported 24 percent clearance rate. That is a 1 percent improvement from 2010.

**VICTIM INFORMATION**

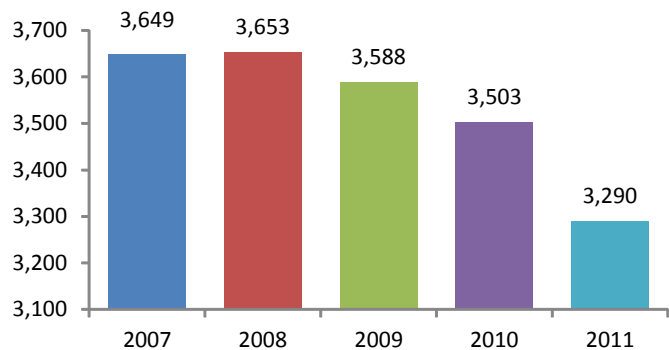
Most of the victims (74 percent) of this offense did not receive any injury. However, 18.3 percent received apparent minor injuries, 5.4 percent received possible internal injuries, and 1.4 percent received other major injuries.

Over 47 percent of the victims had a personal weapon such as hands, fist, feet, etc., used against them. Forty percent (40) of the victims did not have a weapon used against them.

Number of Victims**

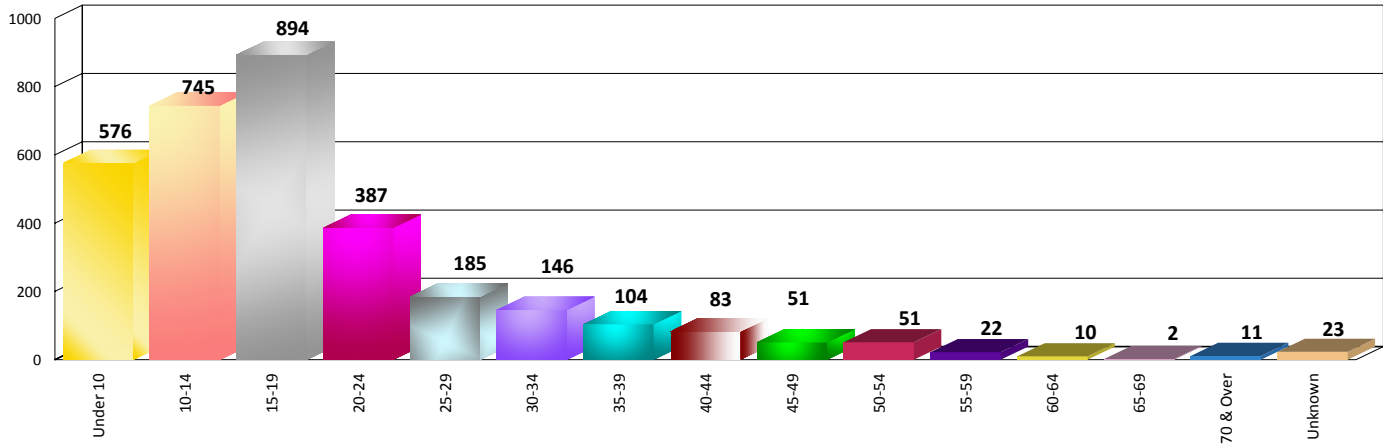


When reviewing the Victim to Offender relationships, 26 percent of the time the victim was an acquaintance of the offender. Twelve (12) percent of the victims were strangers, 10 percent otherwise known, 9.5 percent was the child of the offender, and 9.1 percent was a friend of the offender.

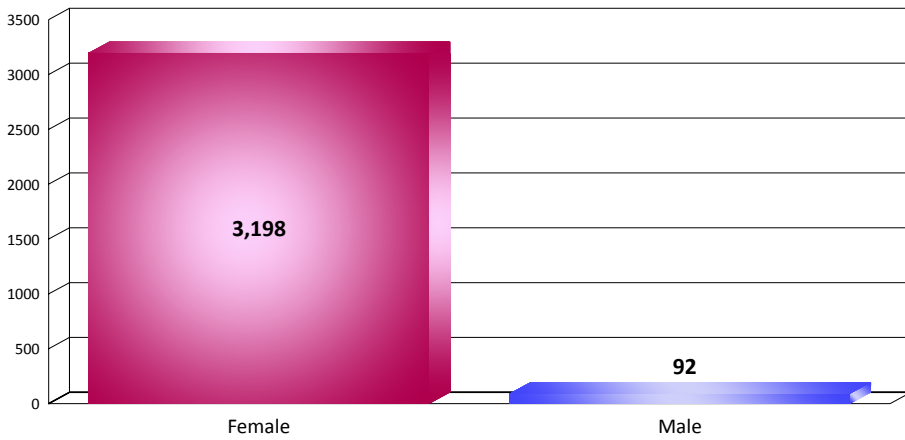
The most reported location was a Residence/Home which equates to 73 percent of the victims. The next highest percentage was the Highway/Road/Alley site at 5 percent.

**Sex of Victims**

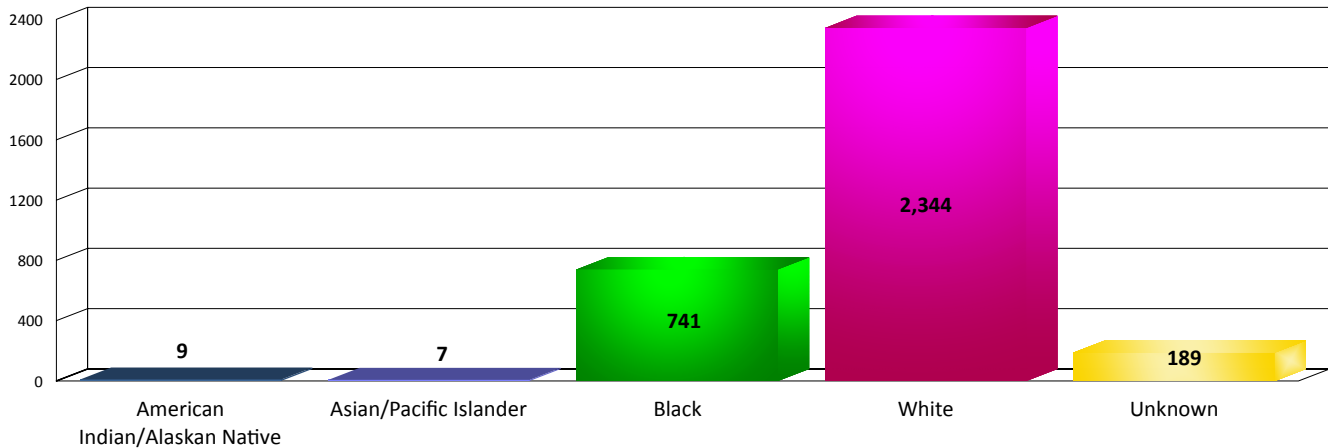


Twenty-seven percent (27%) of the victims were between the ages of 15 and 19. This is a 1 percent decrease from 2010.

Ninety-seven percent (97%) of the victims were females.

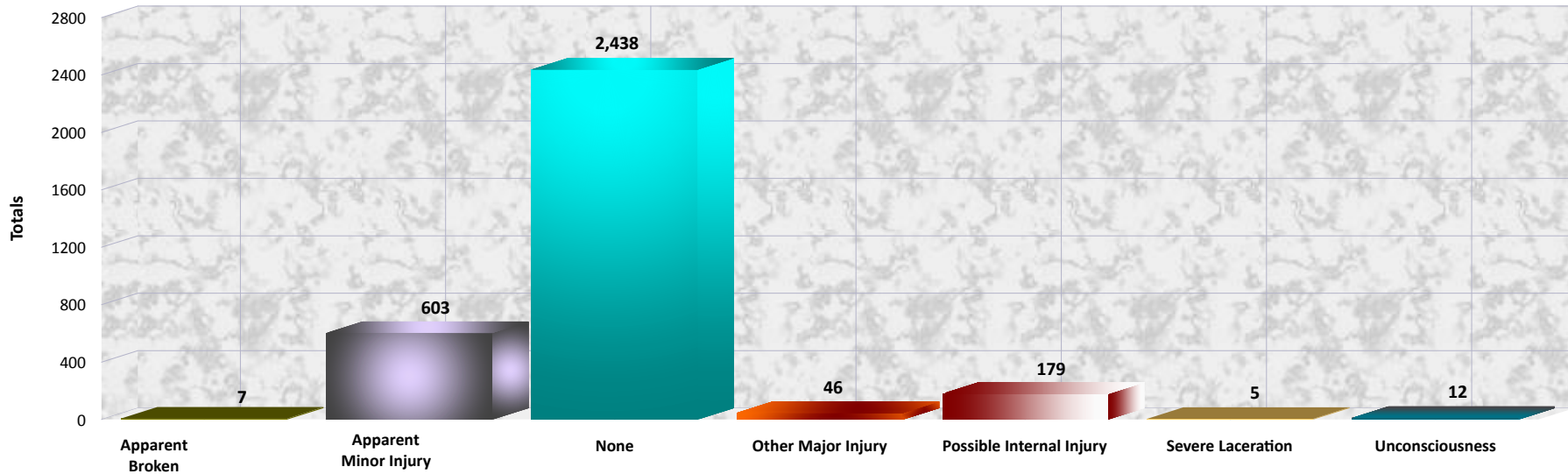
Seventy-one percent (71%) of the victims were White.

**Race of Victims**

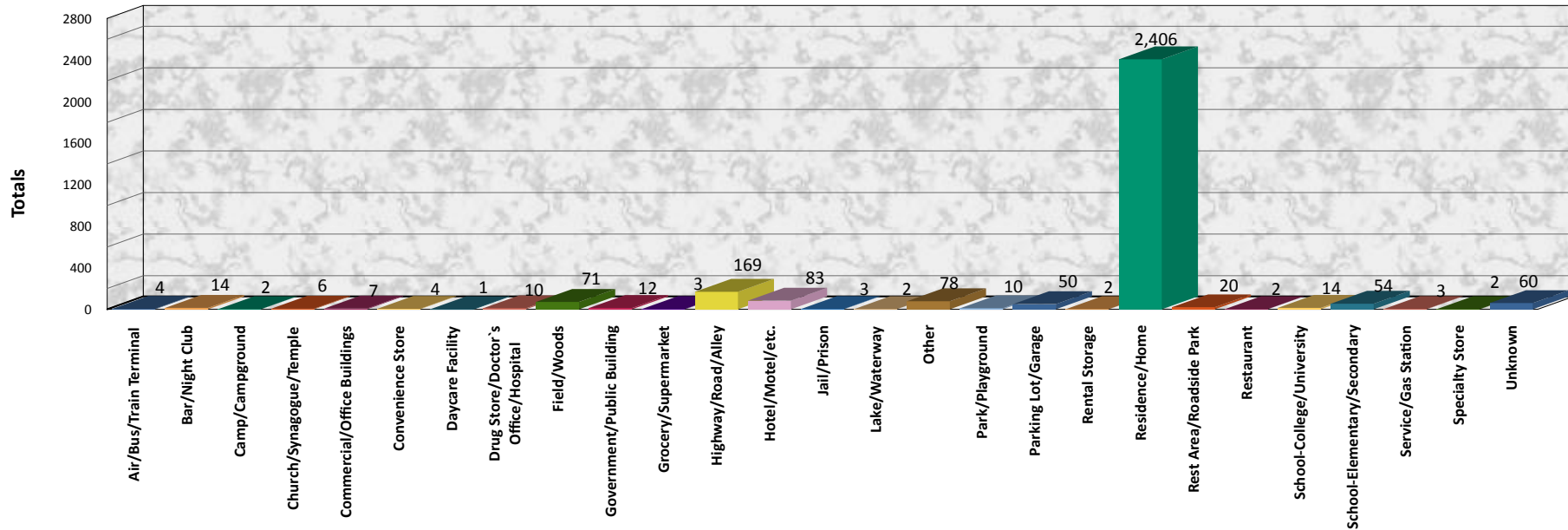




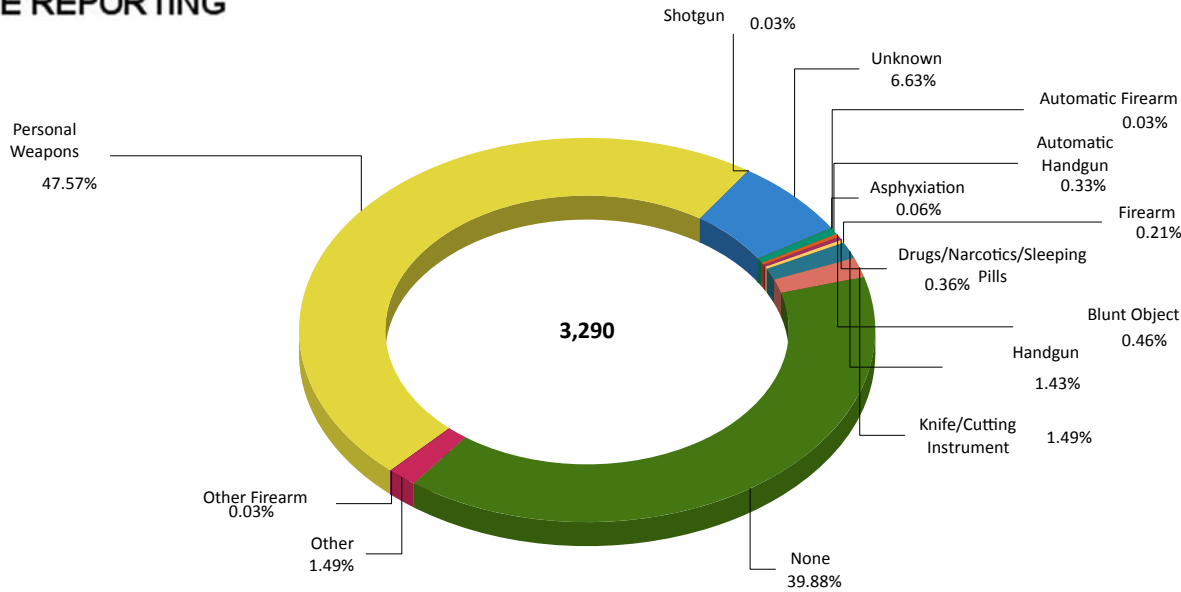
**VICTIM INJURY**



**LOCATION OF CRIME**



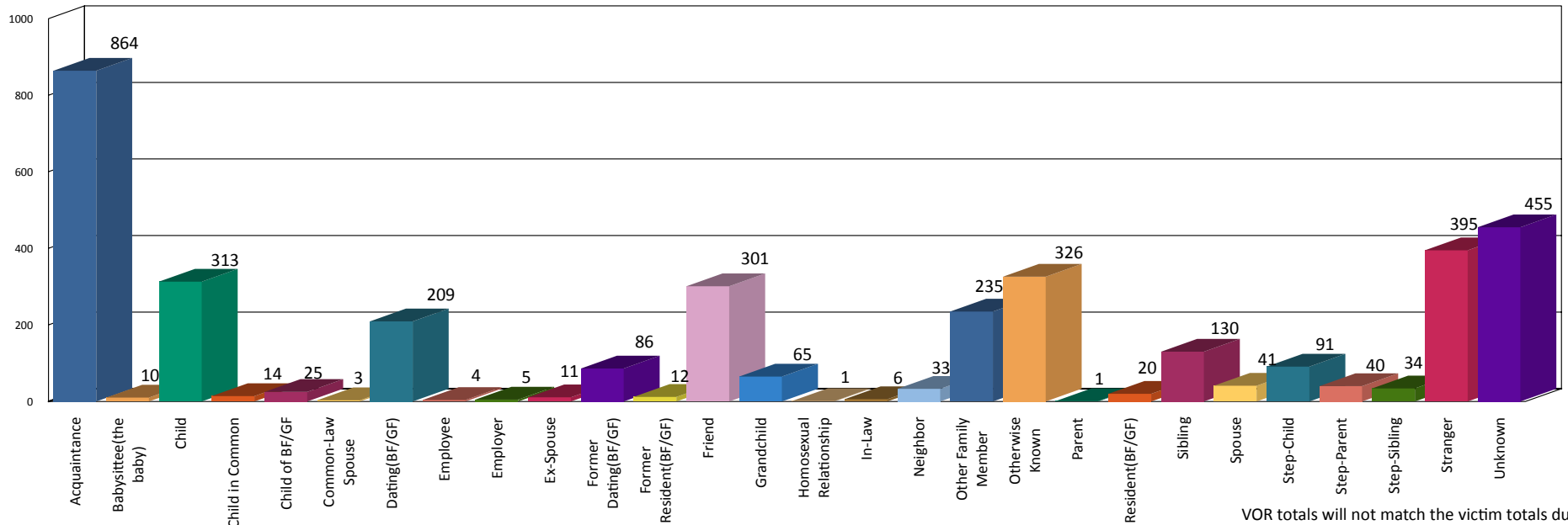

This offense is defined as the sexual intercourse of a person, forcibly and/or against that person's will; or, not forcibly or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity.

**ANALYSIS**

**VOLUME**

The number of victims reported for CSC - 3rd Degree, Sexual Penetration - Penis/Vagina was 1,000. This is a reported decrease of 8 percent from 2010 and a 2.5 percent increase since 2007.

There were more victims in the month of August. December reported fewer victims.

**RATE**

The crime rate for this offense was 10.0 for every 100,000 persons. In 2010, the crime rate was 11.0, a decrease of 1.0 percent.

**CLEARANCES**

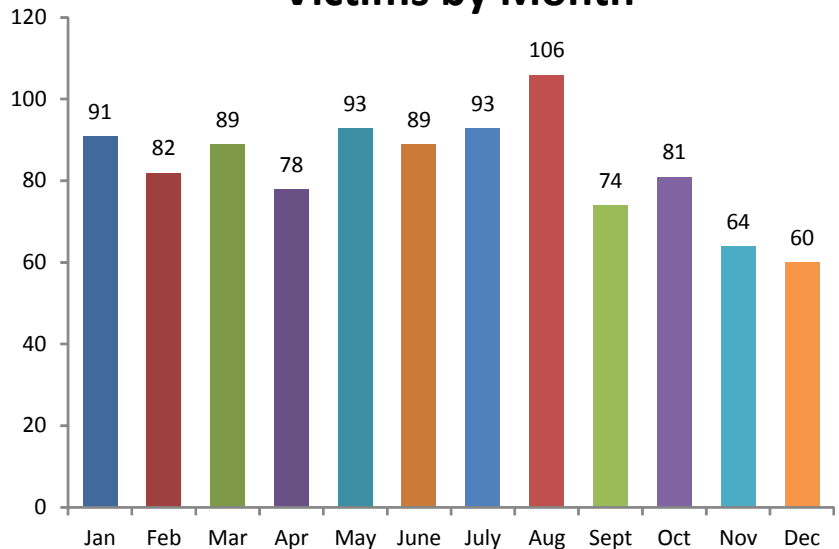
Law enforcement agencies cleared 291 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 962 incidents that were reported. This is a reported 30 percent clearance rate. That is a 3 percent improvement from 2010.

**VICTIM INFORMATION**

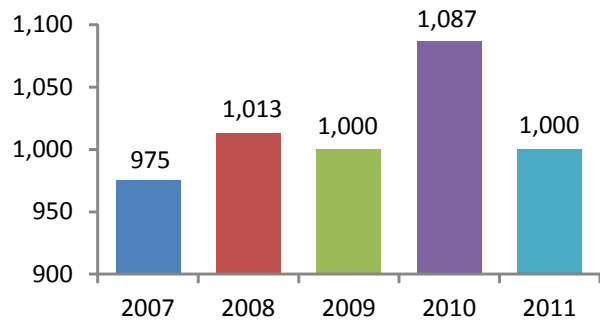
Most of the victims (83 percent) of this offense did not receive any injury. However, 13 percent received apparent minor injuries and 3 percent received possible internal injuries.

The most used weapon occurring 46 percent of the time was a "Personal Weapon" meaning hands, fist, feet, etc. Forty-seven (47) percent of the victims did not have a weapon used against them.

Number of Victims**

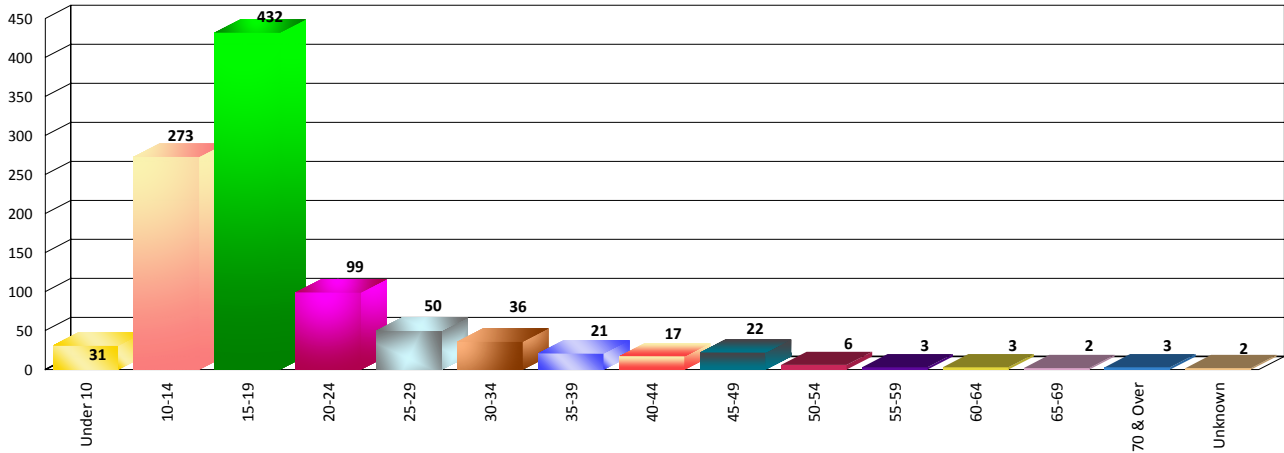


When reviewing the Victim to Offender relationships, 31.7 percent of the time, the victim was an acquaintance of the offender. The "Former Dating (Boyfriend/Girlfriend)" relationship reported 19.6 percent of the victims. Fourteen (14) percent of the time, the victim was a "Friend" of the offender.

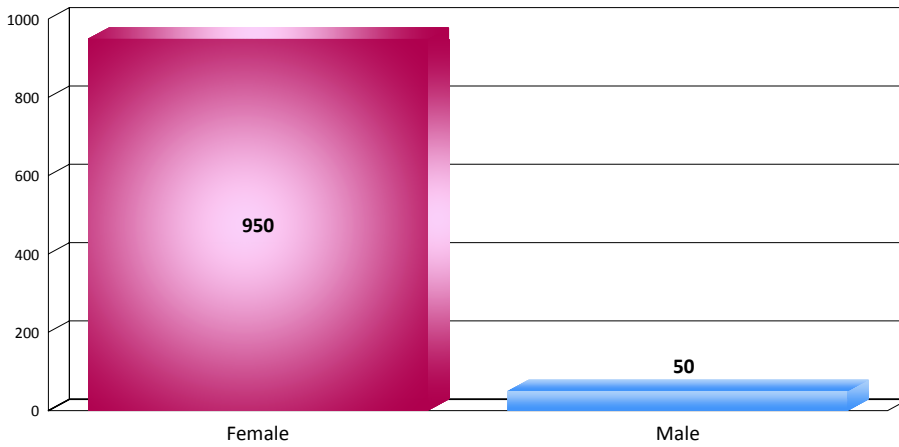
The most reported location was a Residence/Home which equates to 76 percent of the victims. The next highest percentage was the Highway/Road/Alley site at 3.5 percent.

**Sex of Victims**

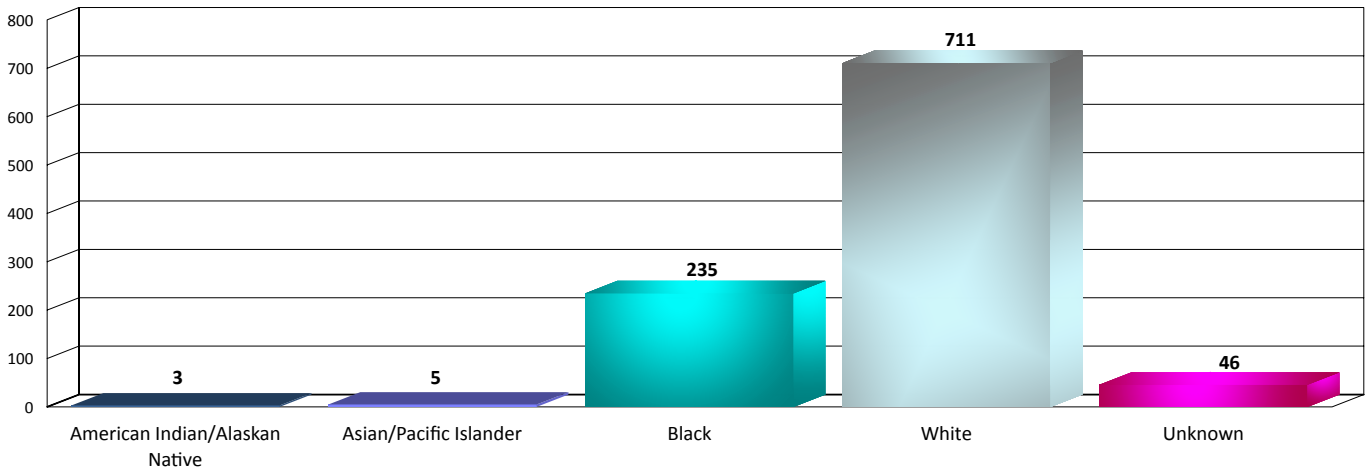


Forty-three percent (43%) of the victims were between the ages of 15 and 19.

Seventy-one percent (71%) of the victims were White.

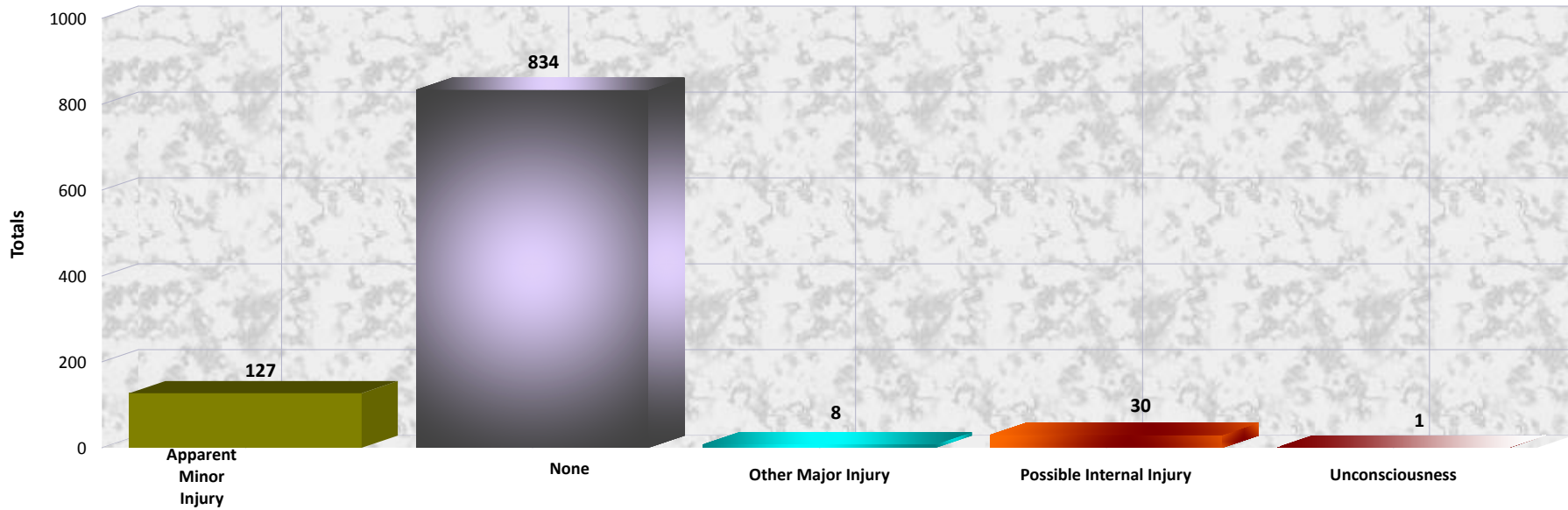
**Race of Victims**



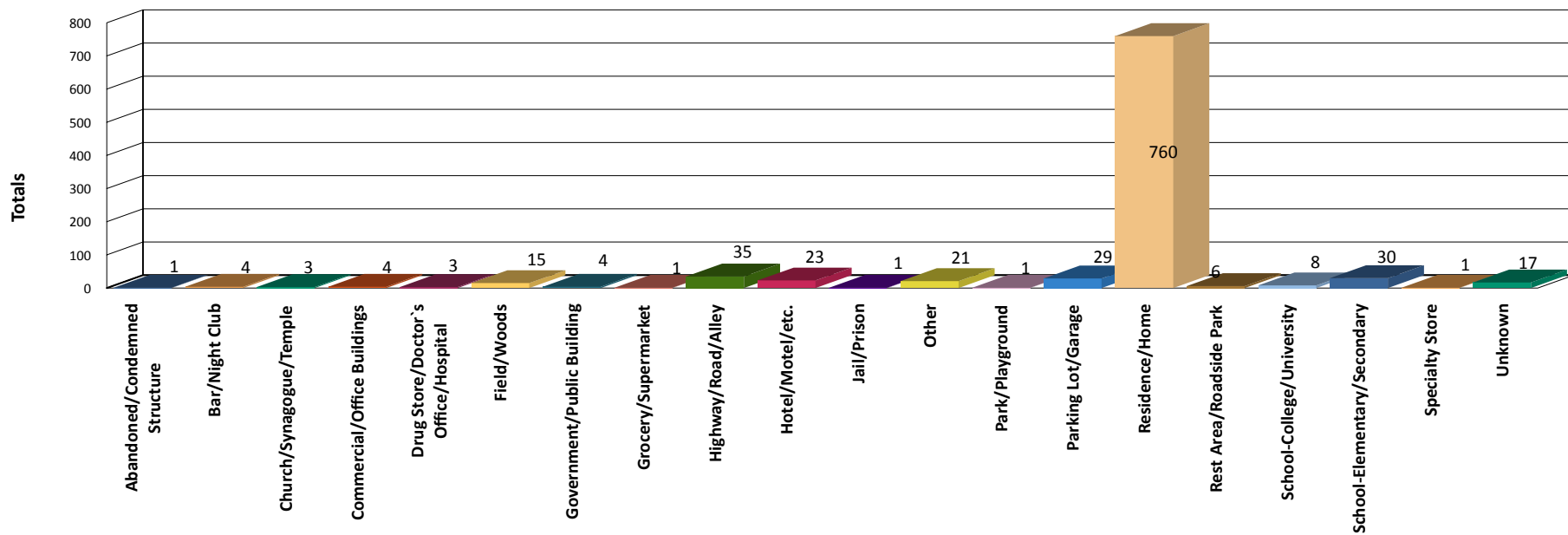




**VICTIM INJURY**



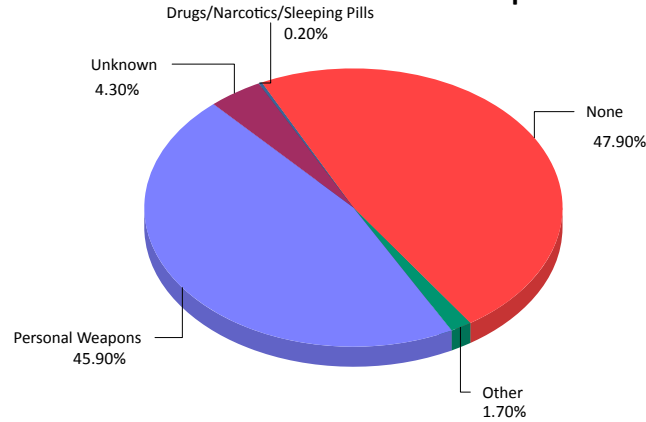
**LOCATION OF CRIME**





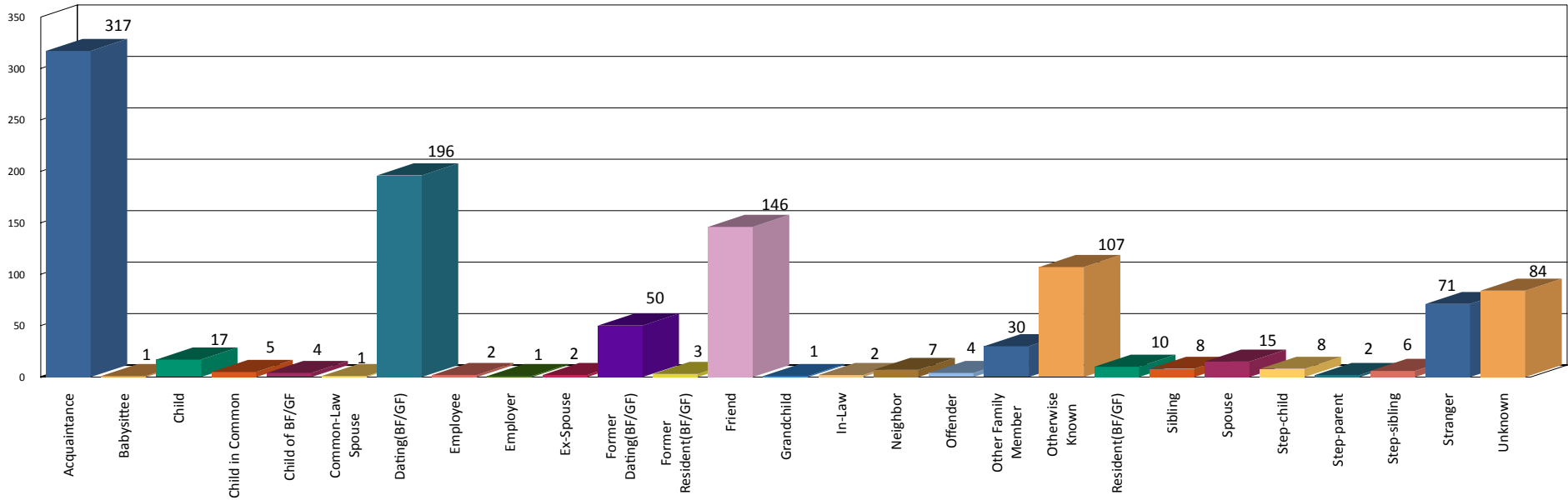
