

DEFINITION

Burglary-Forced Entry is the unlawful forcible entry of a building or other structure with the intent to commit a theft or felony. This does not apply to motor vehicles or coin boxes.

ANALYSIS

VOLUME

The number of burglaries with forced entry committed in Michigan in 2017 was 28,942. This is a reported decrease of six percent from 2016 and a thirty-seven percent decrease since 2013.

The largest number of offenses occurred in the month of July. The least amount occurred in February.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense was 291 for every 100,000 persons. In 2016, the crime rate was 310 per 100,000 persons. This is a reported six percent decrease in the crime rate.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 2,987 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 28,550 incidents reported. This calculates to a ten percent clearance rate.

NATURE

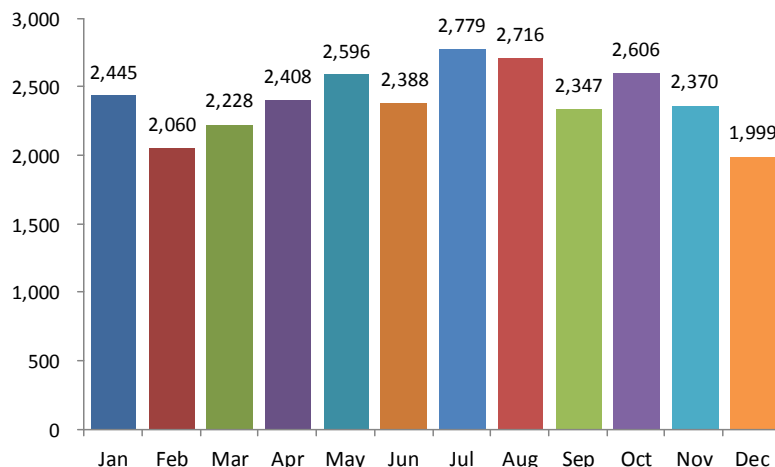
In 2017, seventy-five percent of these offenses occurred most often at a Residence/Home. Commercial/Office Buildings were burglarized three percent of the time. The majority of forced entry burglaries in Michigan for 2017 occurred on Mondays. The least amount of offenses occurred on Saturdays.

OFFENDERS

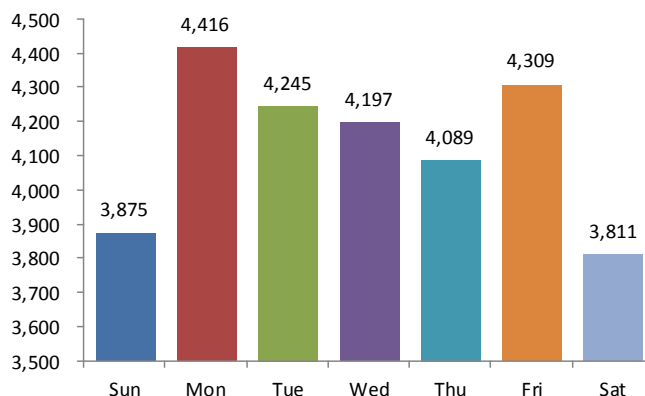
In sixty-two percent of the offenses reported to law enforcement agencies the suspect or offender was Unknown. Among the known offender information, eighty-two percent of the offenders were reported as Males and eighteen percent were Females.

Forty-two percent of the offenses were committed by White Males while eleven percent were committed by White Females. Black Males were involved in thirty-four percent of these offenses and Black Females were involved in six percent of these offenses.

Offenses by Month

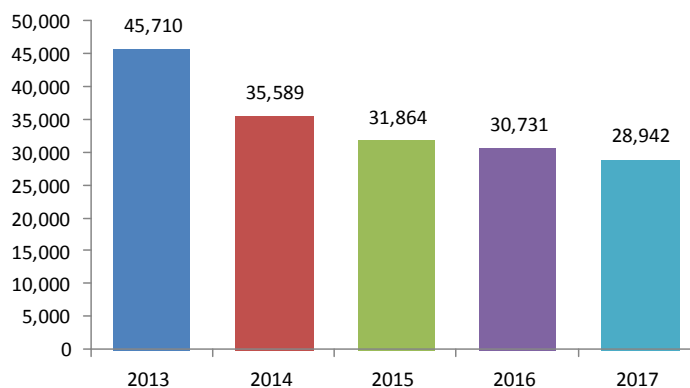


Offenses by Day

Burglary-Entry Without Force is the unlawful entry, without force, with the intent to commit a theft or other felony. This does not apply to motor vehicles or coin boxes.

ANALYSIS

VOLUME

The number of burglaries without forced entry committed in Michigan in 2017 was 6,347. This is a reported decrease of twelve percent from 2016 and a twenty-six percent decrease since 2013.

The largest number of offenses occurred in the month of July and the least amount were committed in February.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense was 64 for every 100,000 persons. This is a decrease of twelve percent from 2016.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 690 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 6,253 incidents reported. This calculates to an eleven percent clearance rate.

NATURE

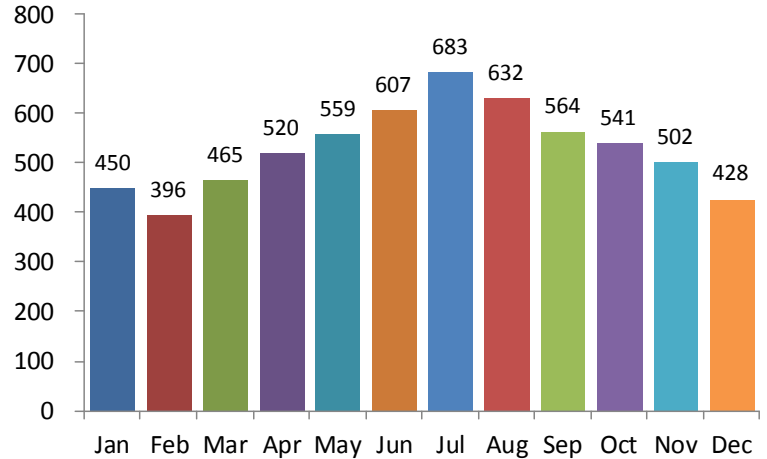
In 2017, eighty-four percent of these crimes occurred at a Residence/Home. Parking Lot/Garage was the location for four percent of the offenses. Burglaries without forced entry occurred most often on Mondays. The least number occurred on Sundays.

OFFENDERS

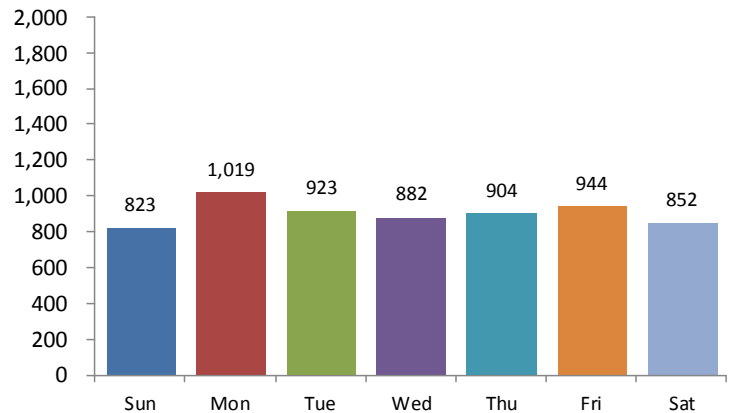
In fifty-four percent of the offenses reported to law enforcement agencies, the suspect or offender was Unknown. Among the offenses where offender information was known (3,316), Males were involved in seventy-eight percent of these offenses and twenty-two percent involved Females.

Forty-four percent of the offenses were committed by White Males and fourteen percent were White Females. Black Males were involved in twenty-eight percent of these offenses and Black Females were involved in six percent of these offenses.

Offenses by Month

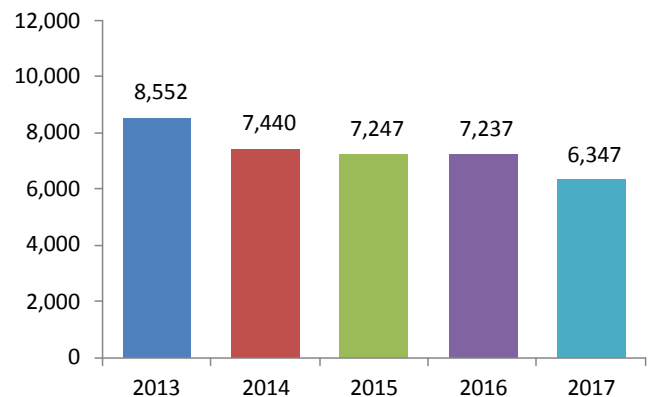


Offenses by Day
