DEFINITION

Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) 1st Degree (MCL 750.520b) is the sexual intercourse of a person, forcibly and/or against that person's will; or, not forcibly or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity. Michigan collects the crime data for this offense based on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Incident Based Reporting System.

Note: CSC 1st and 3rd are differentiated by the weapon involved and the degree of the victim injury.

ANALYSIS

VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 1st Degree, Sexual Penetration - Penis/Vagina was 3,333. This is a reported increase of five percent from 2016 and a three percent increase from 2013.

The month of May had the most victims reported. The fewest number of victims were reported in December.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2017 was 33 for every 100,000 persons. In 2016, the crime rate was 32 for every 100,000 persons, an increase of three percent.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 741 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 3,168 incidents reported. This is a reported twenty-three percent clearance rate.


VICTIM INFORMATION

Seventy-five percent of the victims did not receive any injury. There were sixteen percent of victims who received Apparent Minor injuries and seven percent received Possible Internal injuries.


Thirty-two percent of the victims had a Personal Weapon such as hands, fists, feet, etc., used against them. Fifty-seven percent of the victims did not have a weapon used against them.

When reviewing the Victim to Offender relationships, nineteen percent of the time the victim was an Acquaintance of the offender. With fourteen percent of the victims, the Victim to Offender relationship was not known to law enforcement. Twelve percent were Otherwise Known and ten percent were reported as a Friend.

Victims by Month




Victims by Day





Location of Crime








Michigan collects the crime data for this offense based on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Incident Based Reporting System.

VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 3rd Degree, Sexual Penetration - Penis/Vagina was 1,238. This is a reported increase of four percent from 2016.

More victims were reported in the month of March than any other month. The fewest number of victims were reported in September. The most victims were reported on Mondays.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2017 was 12 for every 100,000 persons. The crime rate was also 12 for every 100,000 persons in 2016.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 359 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 1,196 incidents that were reported. This is a reported thirty percent clearance rate.

DEFINITION

Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) 3rd Degree (MCL 750.520d) is the sexual intercourse of a person, forcibly and/or against that person's will; or, not forcibly or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity. Michigan collects the crime data for this offense based on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Incident Based Reporting System.

Note: CSC 1st and 3rd are differentiated by the weapon involved and the degree of the victim injury.

ANALYSIS

VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 3rd Degree, Sexual Penetration-Object was 200. This is a reported increase of two percent from 2016 and a thirty percent increase from 2013.

More victims were reported in the month of September than any other month. The most victims were reported on Tuesdays.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2017 was two for every 100,000 persons, which is the same rate that was reported in 2016.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 46 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 184 incidents that were reported. This is a reported twenty-five percent clearance rate.

VICTIM INFORMATION


Eighty-four percent of the victims did not receive any injury. There were ten percent of victims who received Apparent Minor injuries and seven percent received Possible Internal injuries.

Fifty-eight percent of the victims did not have a weapon used against them. The most used weapon, occurring thirty-nine percent of the time, was a Personal Weapon meaning hands, fists, feet, etc.


When reviewing the Victim to Offender relationships, twenty-three percent of the time, the victim was an Acquaintance of the offender. With twelve percent of the victims, the Victim to Offender relationship was Friend.

The most reported location was a Residence/Home, which equates to seventy percent of the incidents.

Victims by Month




Victims by Day








Forty-one percent of the victims were between the ages of 15 and 19.


Gender Analysis
