

DEFINITION

Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) 1st Degree (MCL 750.520b)

is the sexual intercourse of a person, forcibly and/or against that person's will; or, not forcibly or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity. Michigan collects the crime data for this offense based on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Incident Based Reporting System.

Note: CSC 1st and 3rd Degree are differentiated by the weapon involved and the degree of the victim injury. CSC 2nd and 4th Degree (forcible contact) are not included in the Rape category per the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Uniform Crime Reporting Program.

ANALYSIS

VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 1st Degree, Sexual Penetration - Penis/Vagina was 3,146. This is a reported decrease of 14 percent from 2018 and a four percent increase from 2015. The month of September had the most victims reported. The fewest number of victims were reported in December.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2019 was 32 for every 100,000 persons. In 2018, the crime rate was 37 for every 100,000 persons, a decrease of 15 percent.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 705 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 2,991 incidents reported. This is a reported 24 percent clearance rate.

VICTIM INFORMATION

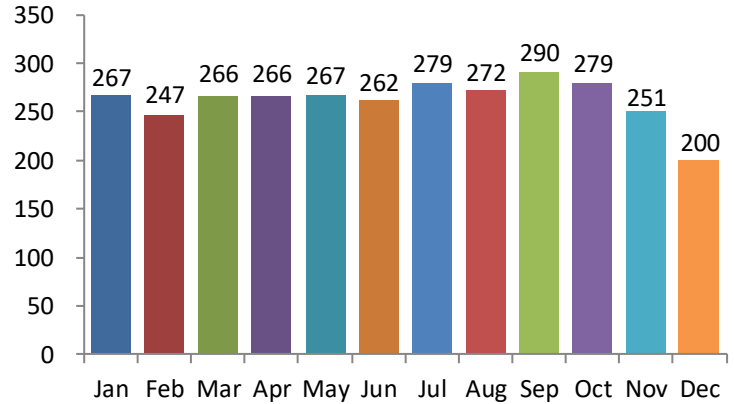
Seventy-eight percent of the victims did not receive any injury. Thirteen percent of the victims received Apparent Minor injuries, and six percent received Possible Internal injuries.

Twenty-six percent of the victims had a Personal Weapon (e.g., hands, fists, feet, etc.), used against them. Sixty-one percent of the victims did not have a weapon used against them.

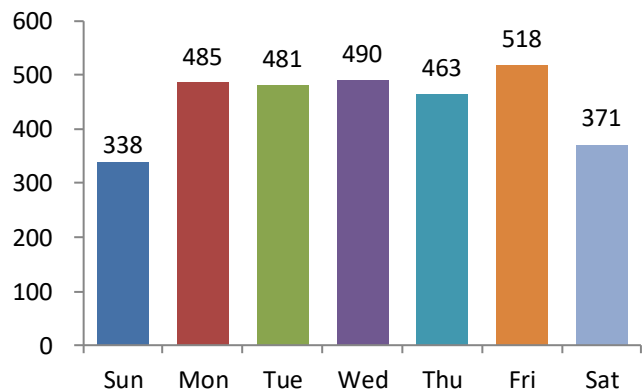
When reviewing the Victim to Offender relationships, 14 percent of the time the victim was an Acquaintance of the offender. With 15 percent of the victims, the Victim to Offender relationship was not known to law enforcement. Eleven percent were Otherwise Known and 10 percent were reported as a Friend.

Seventy-seven percent of the incidents occurred at the location of Residence/Home. Four percent of the incidents occurred at the Highway/Roadway/Alley location.

Victims by Month

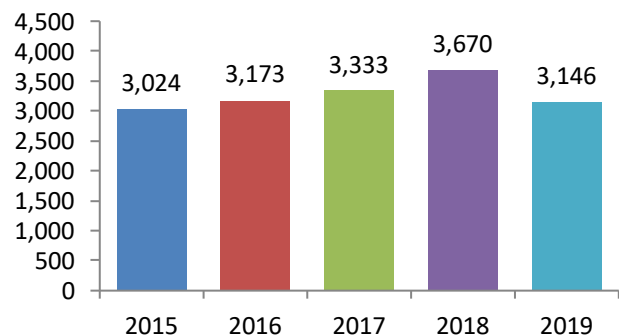

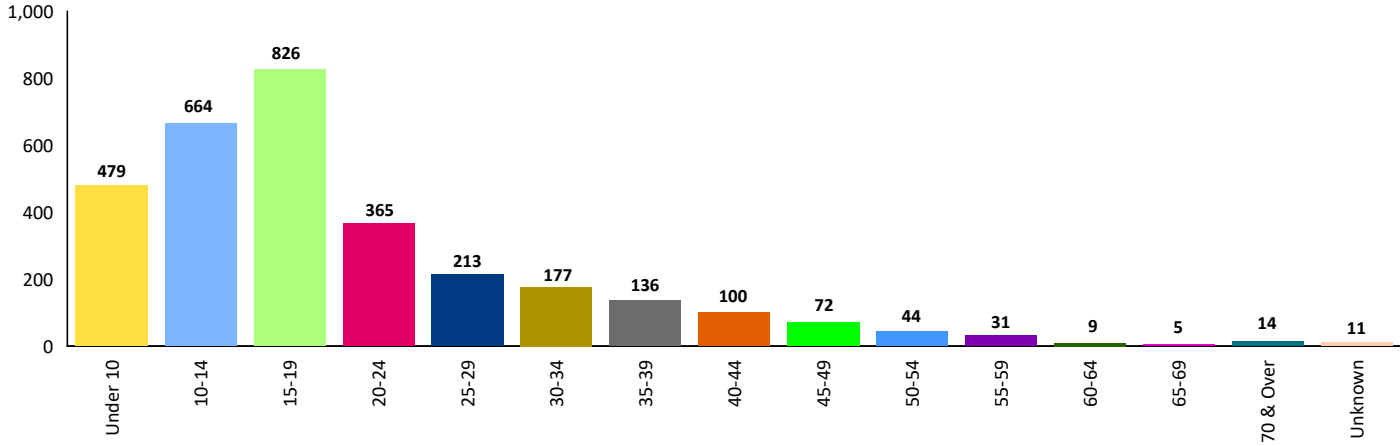

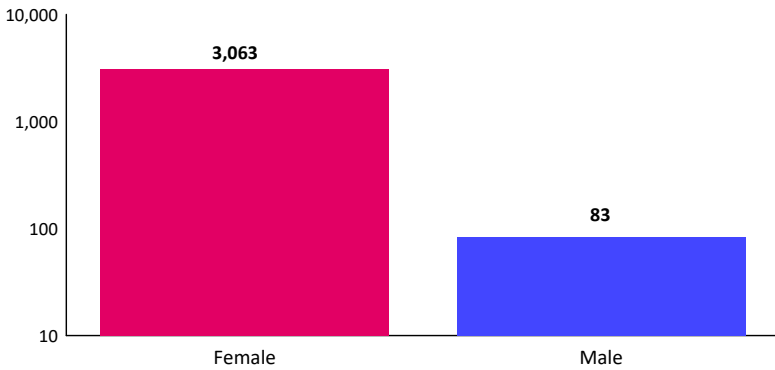

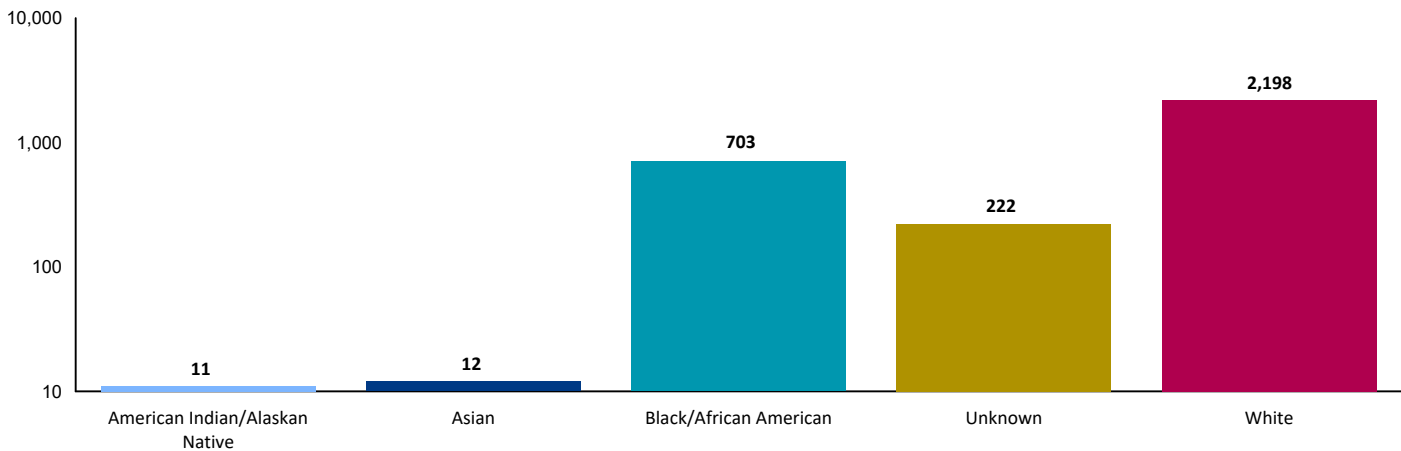
Gender Analysis

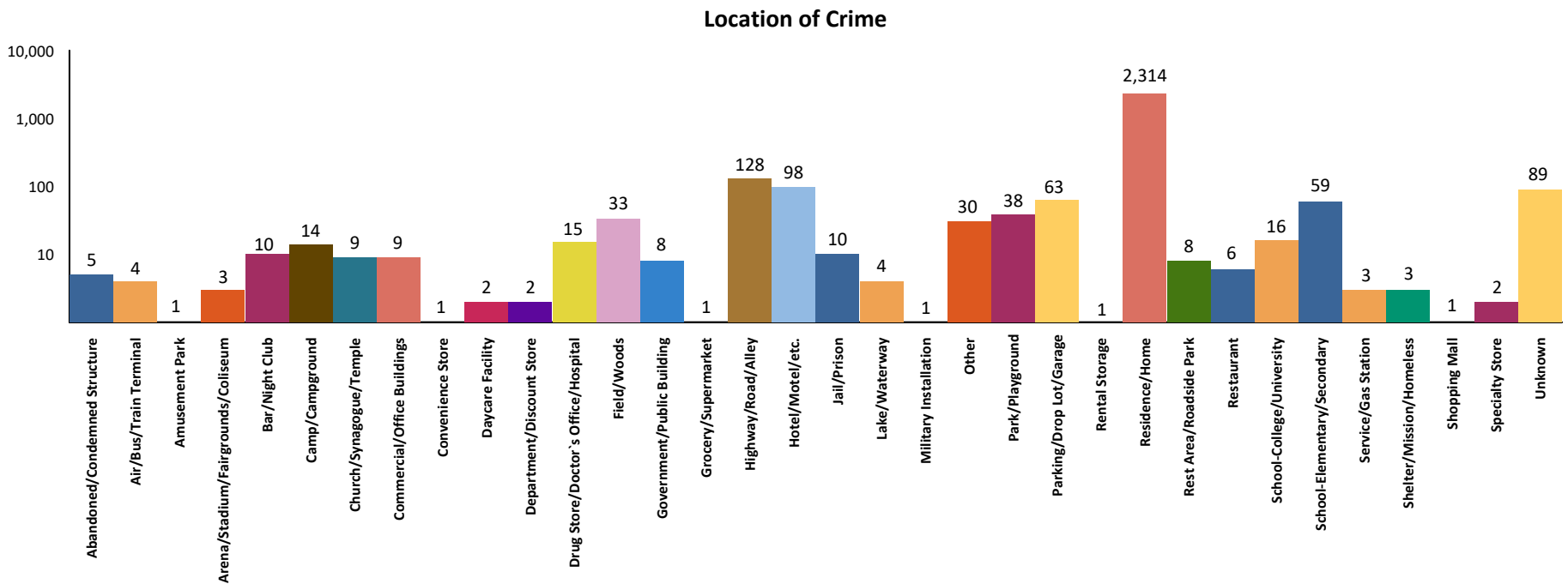
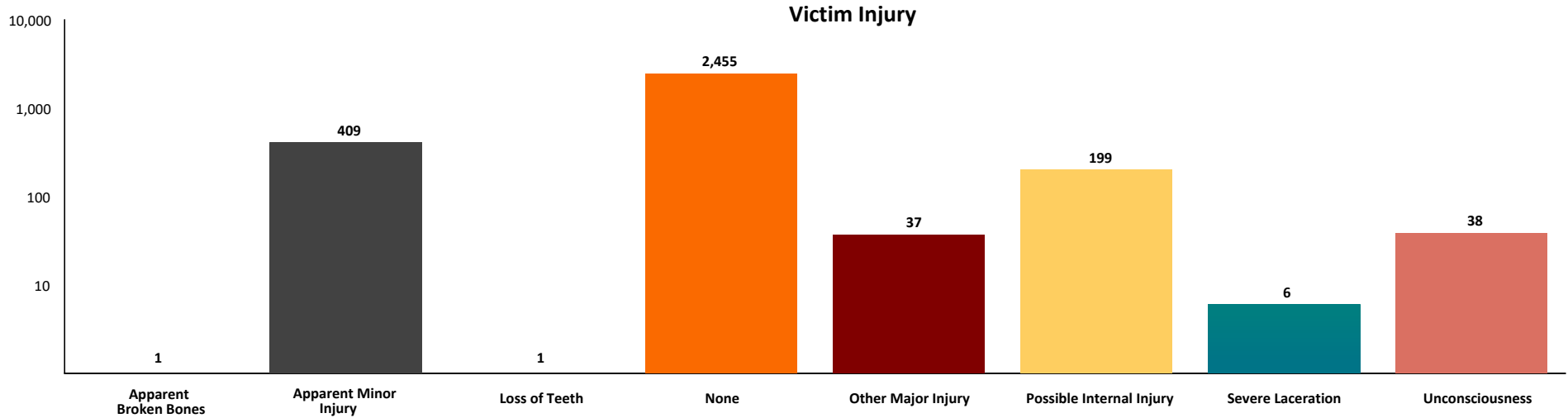

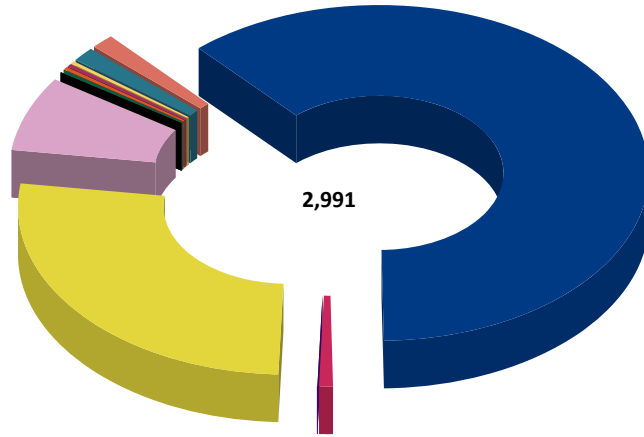
Race of Victims

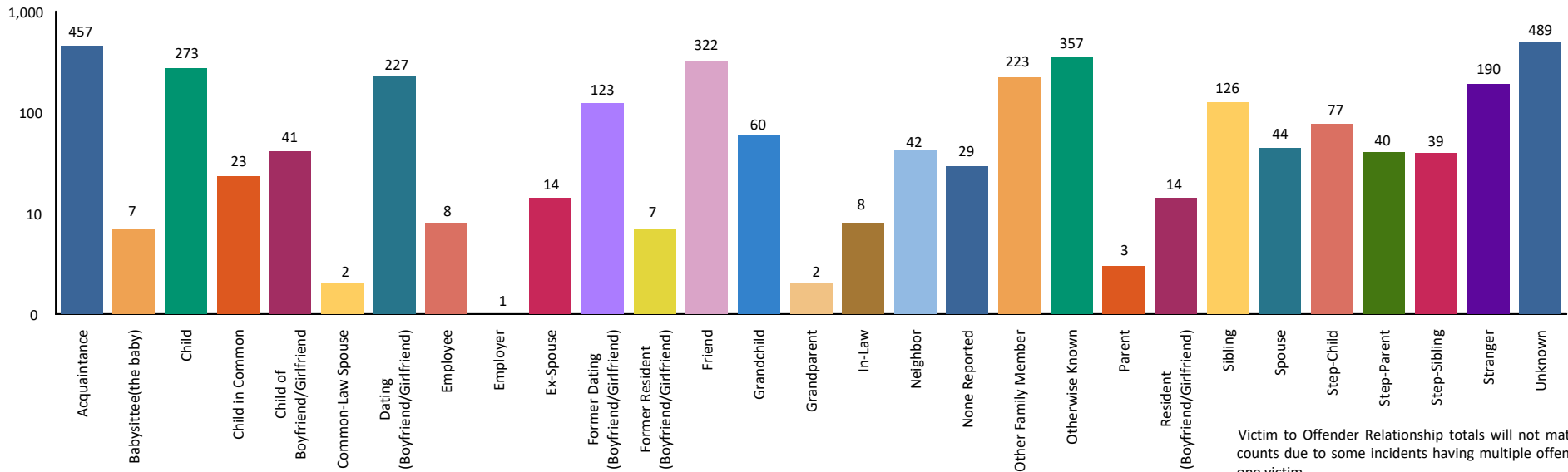

VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 3rd Degree, Sexual Penetration - Penis/Vagina was 1,312. This is a reported decrease of four percent from 2018.

More victims were reported in the months of March and July, equally. The fewest number of victims were reported in December. The most victims were reported on Tuesdays.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2019 was 13 for every 100,000 persons. The crime rate was 14 for every 100,000 persons in 2018.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 368 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 1,280 incidents that were reported. This is a reported 29 percent clearance rate.

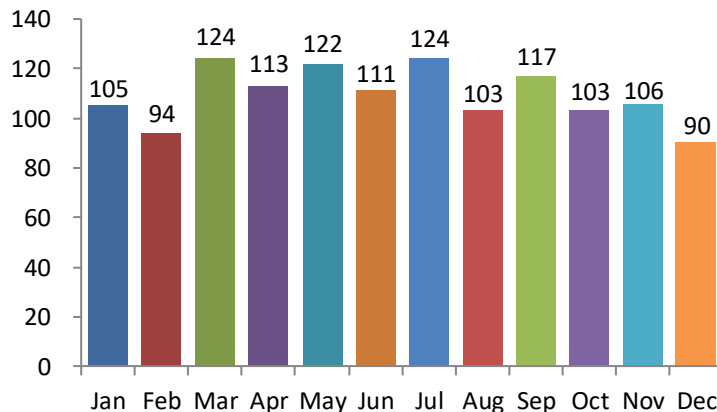

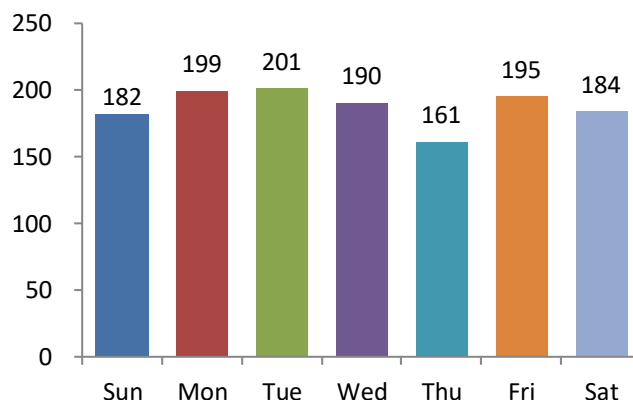

The most commonly reported location was a Residence/Home, accounting for 75 percent of the incidents. The next highest percentage was four percent at a Hotel/Motel.

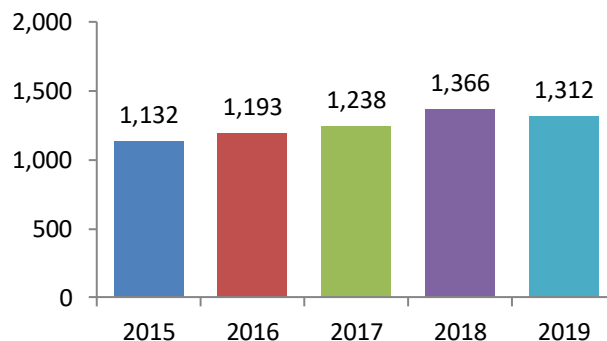
Victims by Month



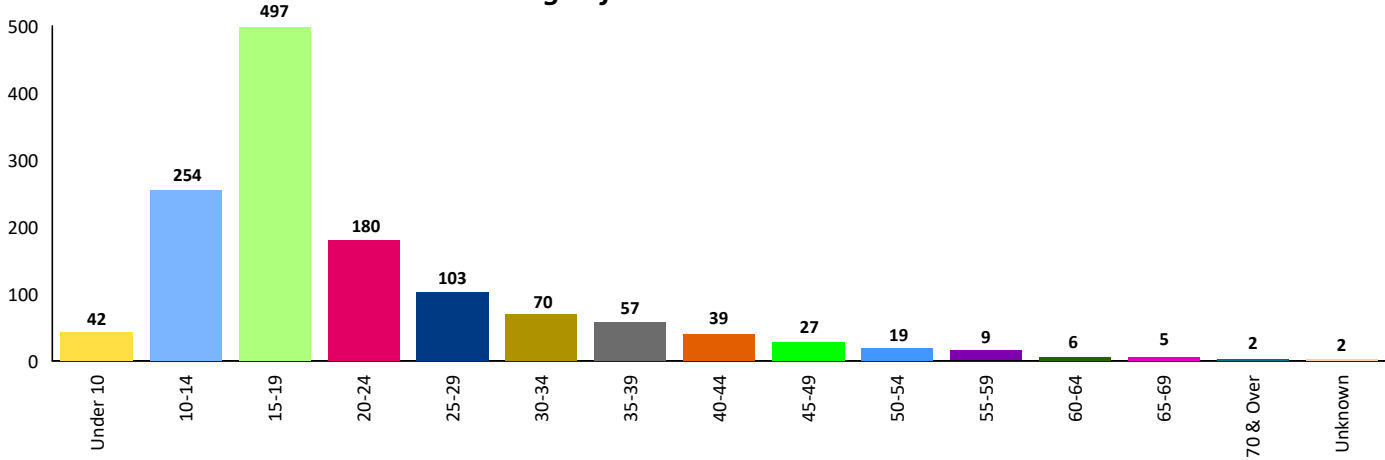
Victims by Day

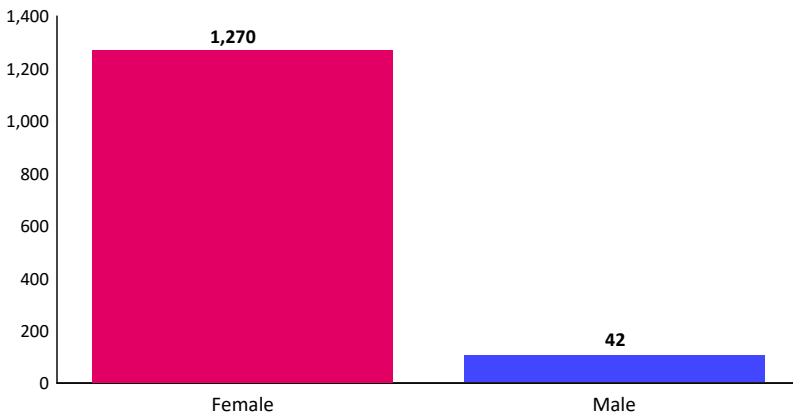

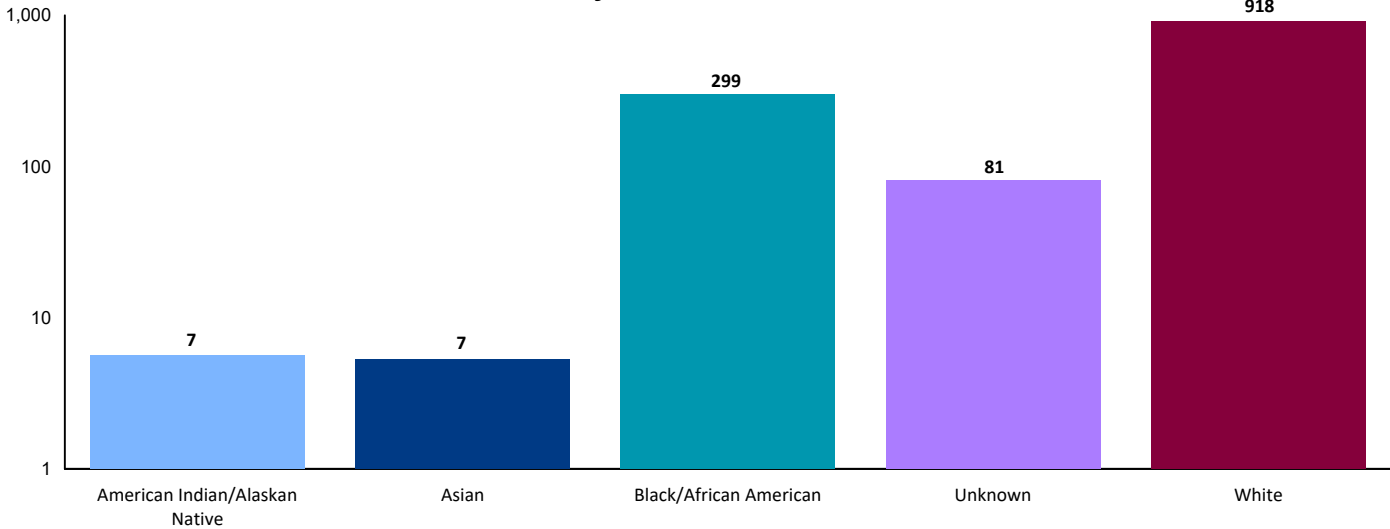

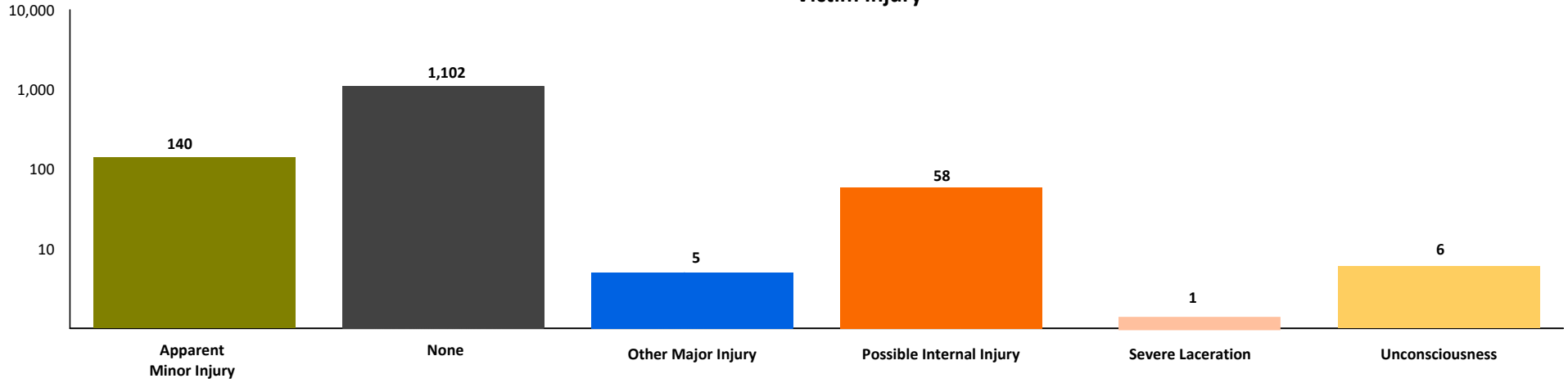

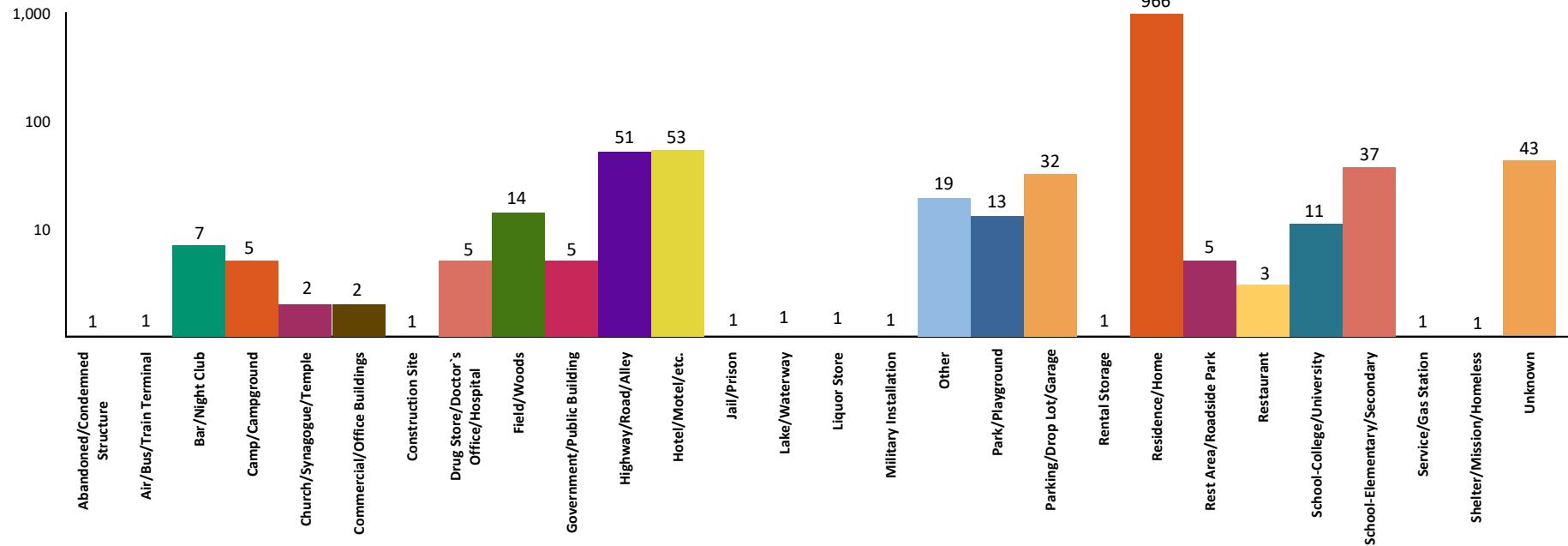

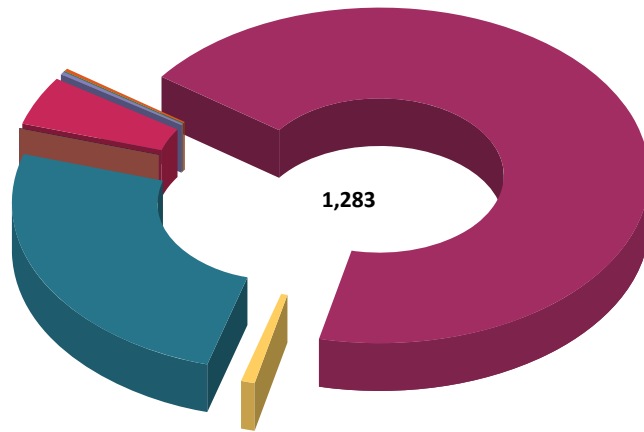
Victim Injury

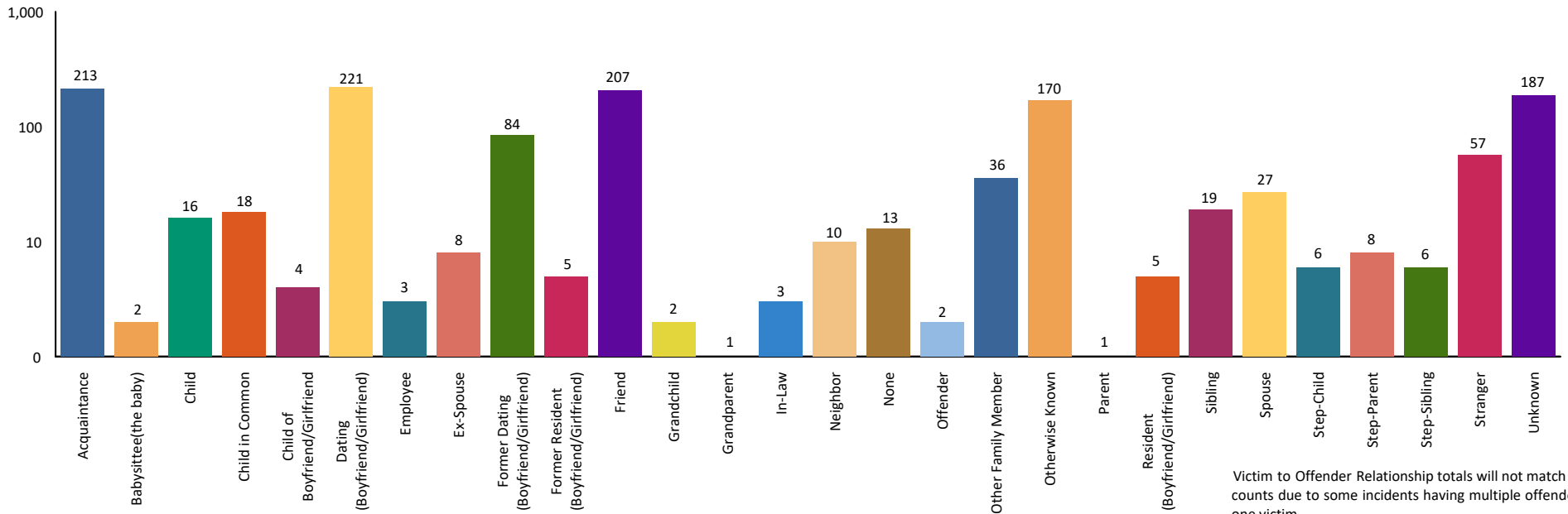

The largest number of victims were reported in the month of January. The fewest number of victims were reported in December. Wednesday was the most common day for reporting victims of this crime.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2019 was 13 for every 100,000 persons. In 2018, the crime rate was also 13 for every 100,000 persons.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 260 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 1,091 incidents that were reported. This is a reported 24 percent clearance rate.

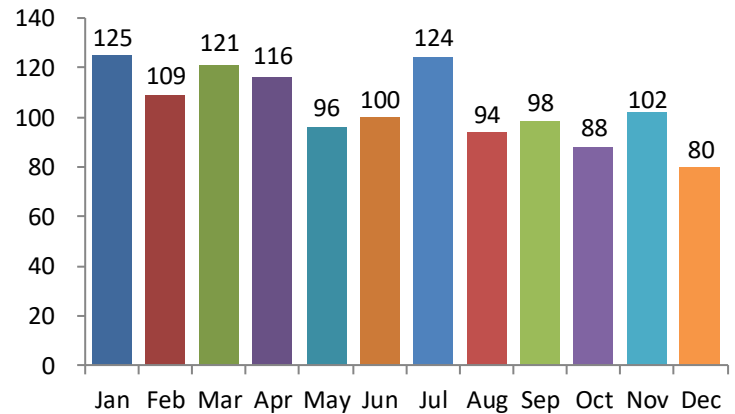

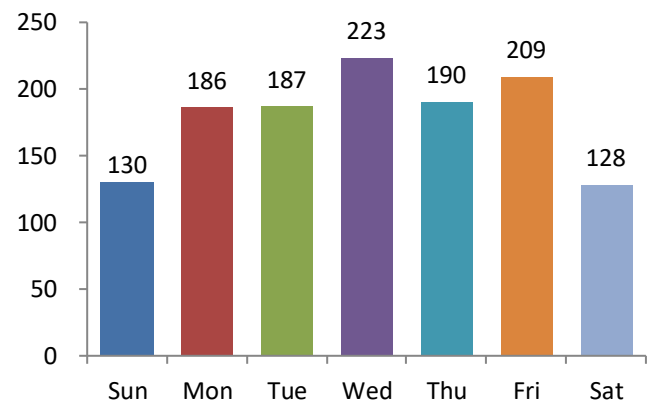

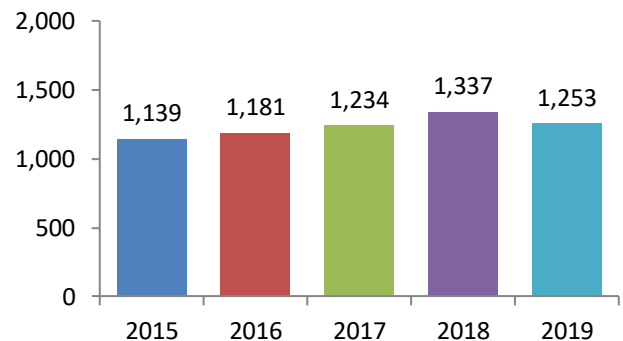

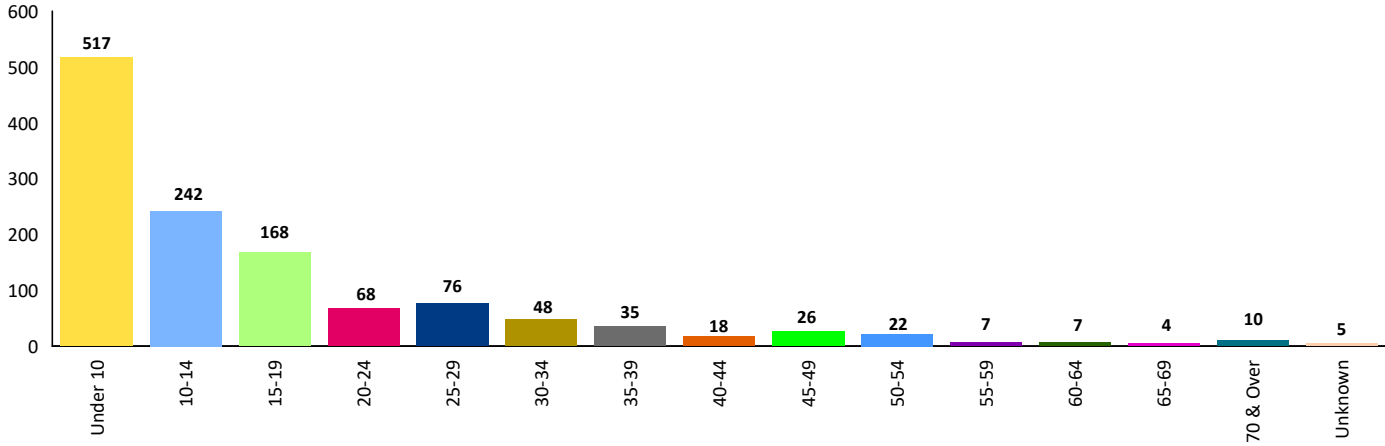

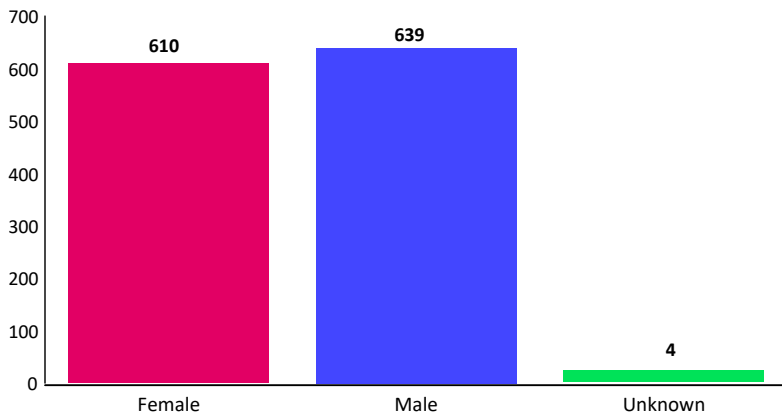

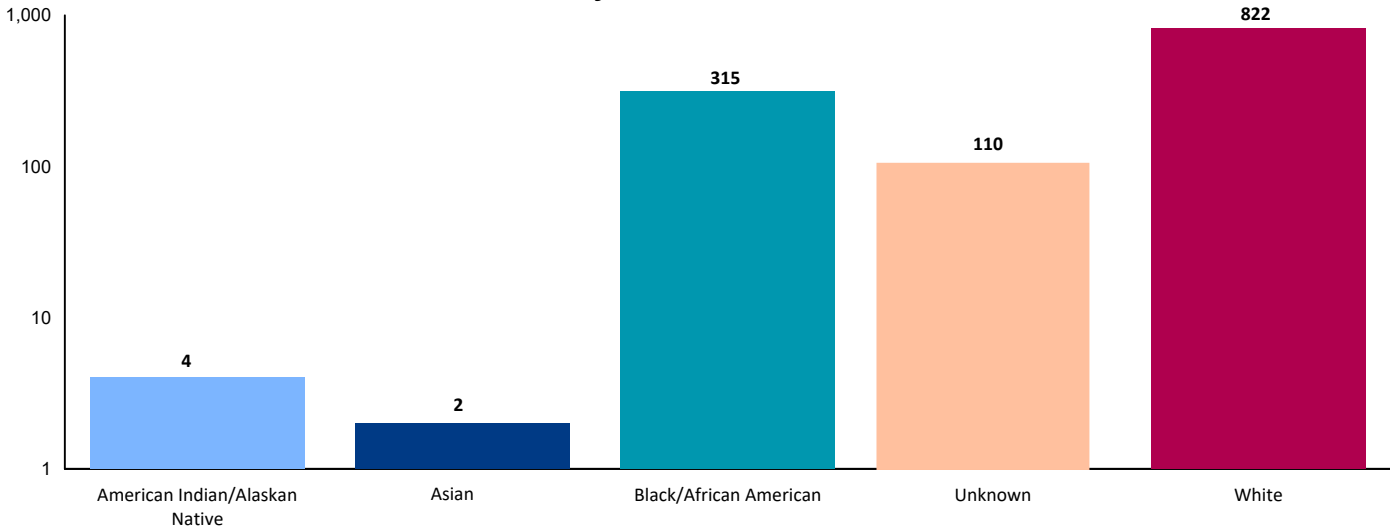

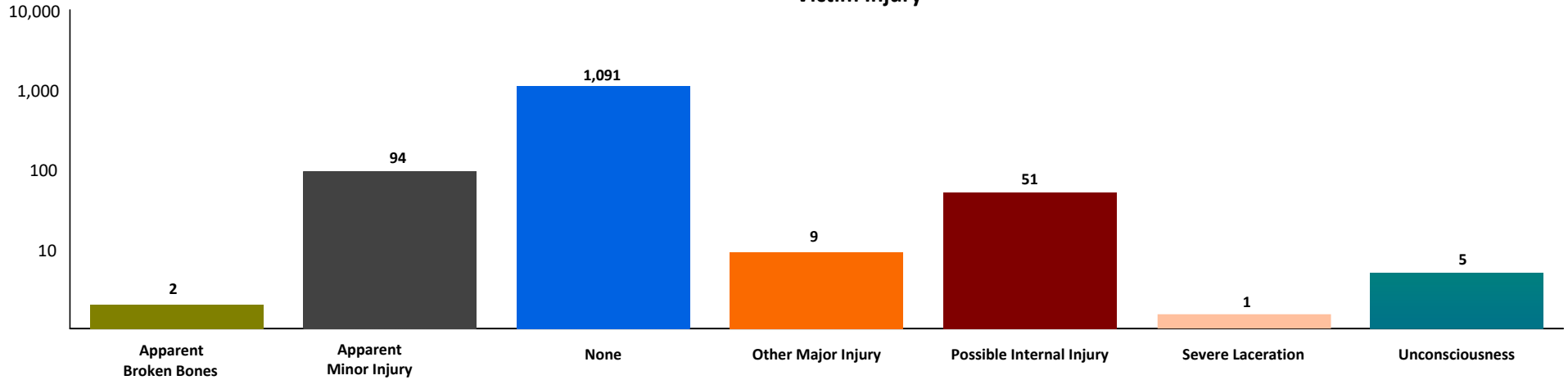

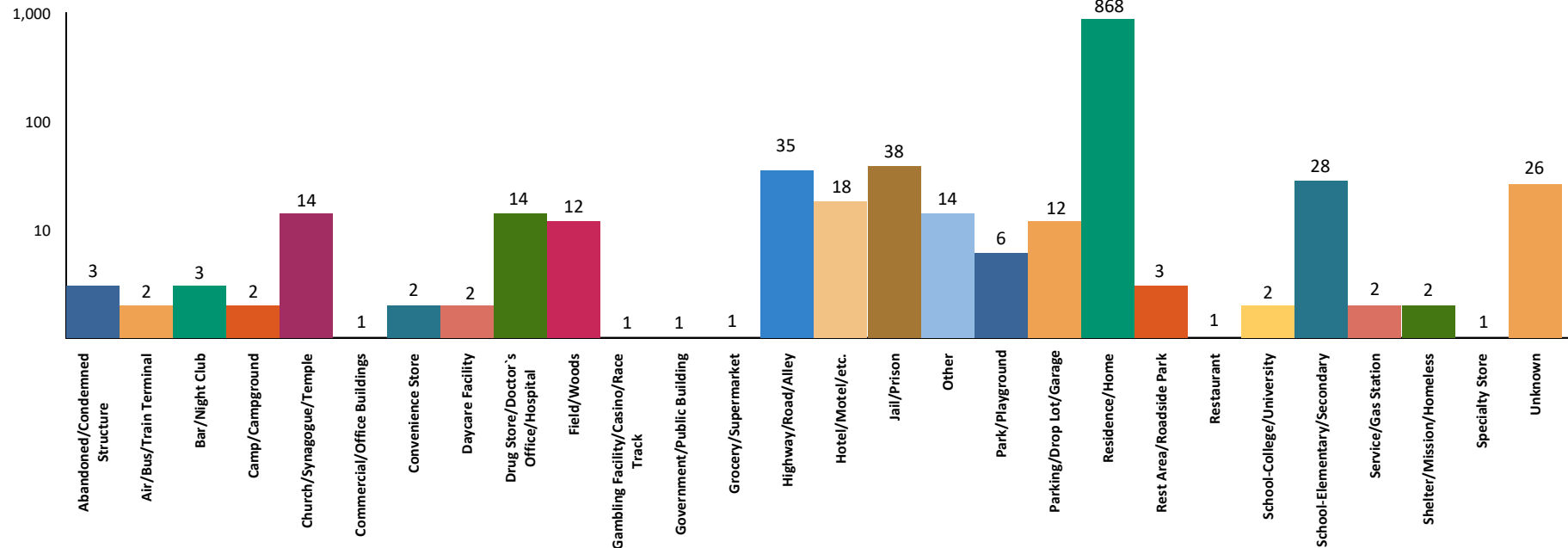

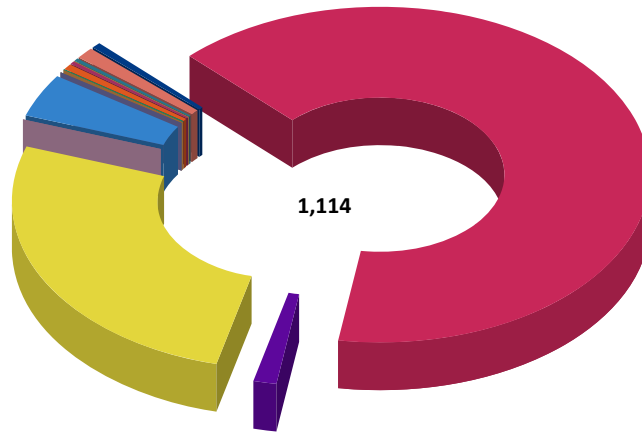

VOLUME

More victims were reported in the month of April than any other month. The fewest number of victims were reported in January. These crimes occurred most often on Wednesdays.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2019 was five for every 100,000 persons. In 2018, the crime rate was six for every 100,000 persons.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 120 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 473 incidents that were reported. This is a reported 25 percent clearance rate.

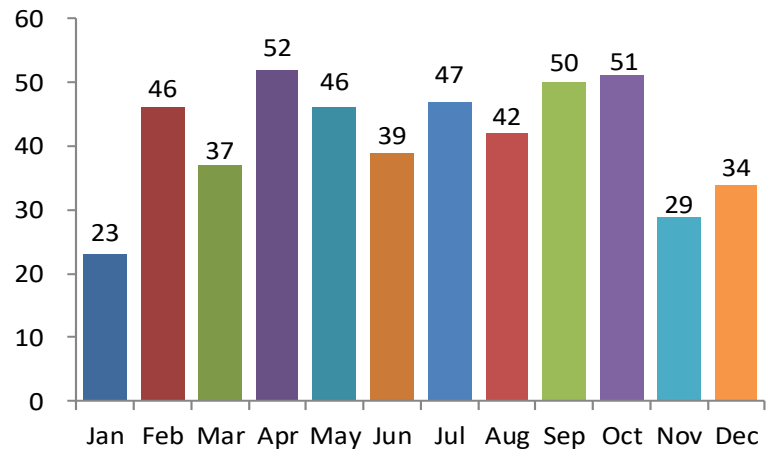

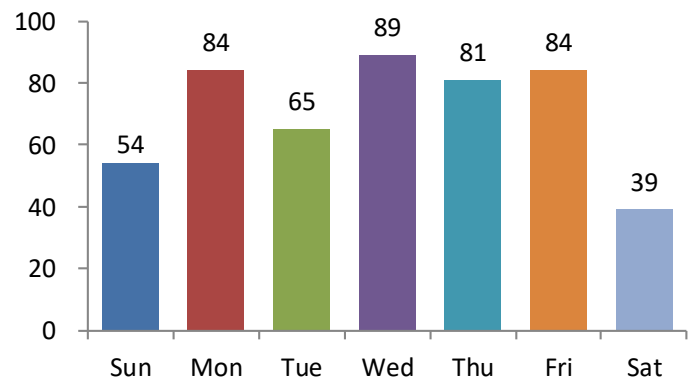

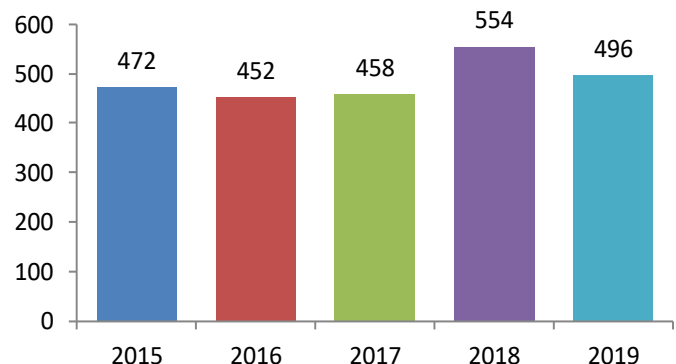
Victims by Month



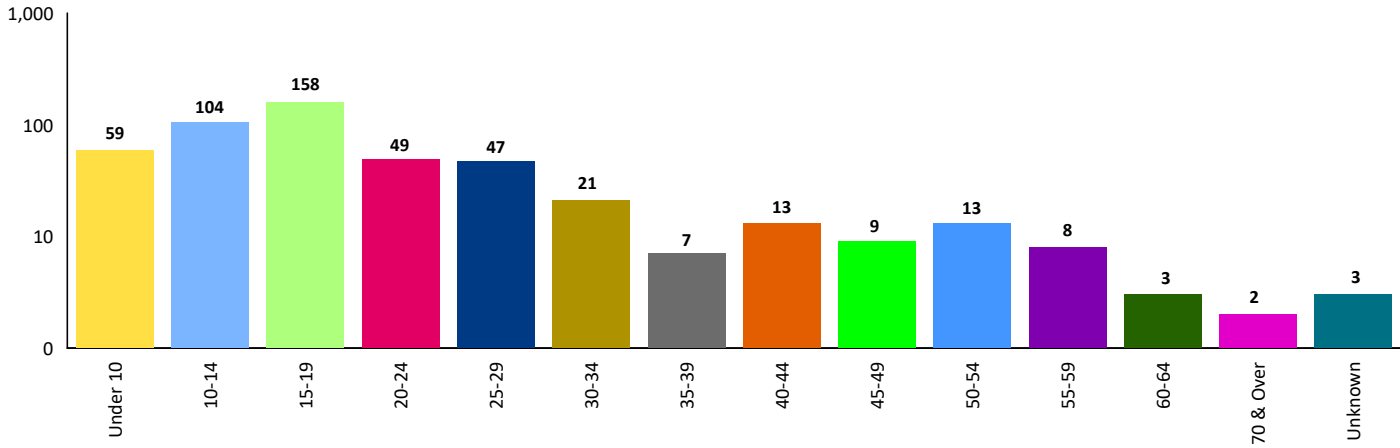

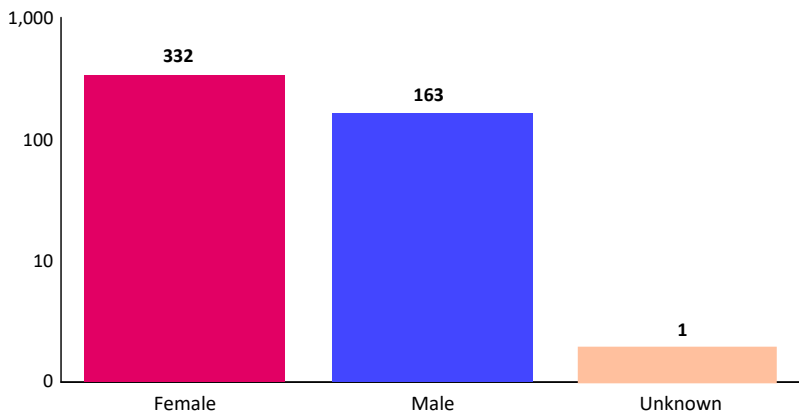

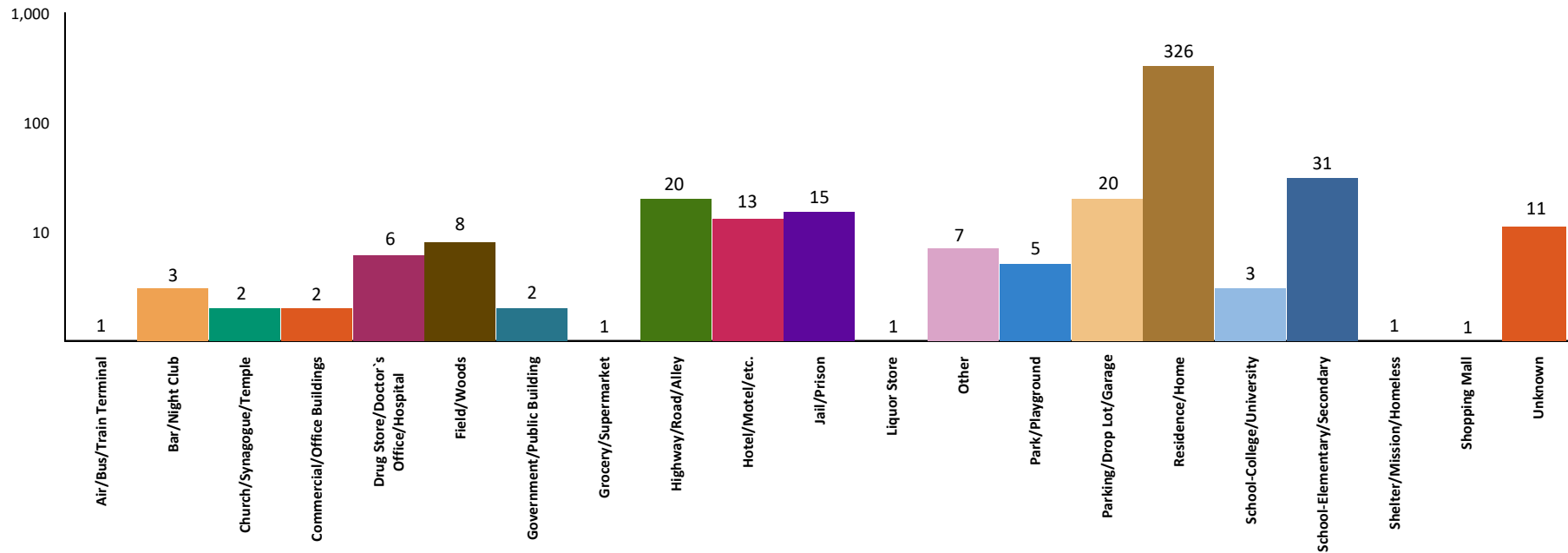


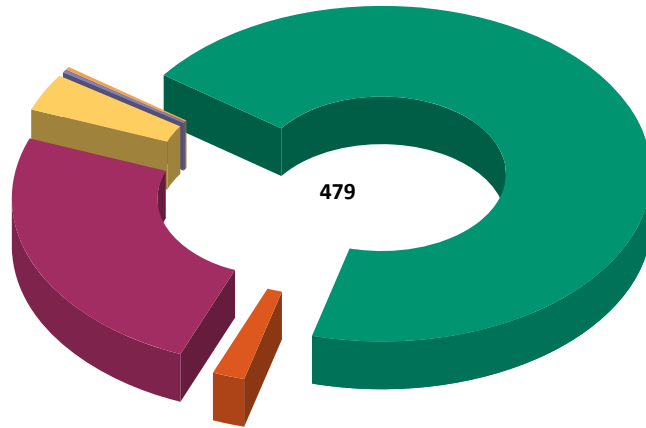
2019 CSC - 3rd Degree Sexual Penetration-Oral/Anal

Location of Crime



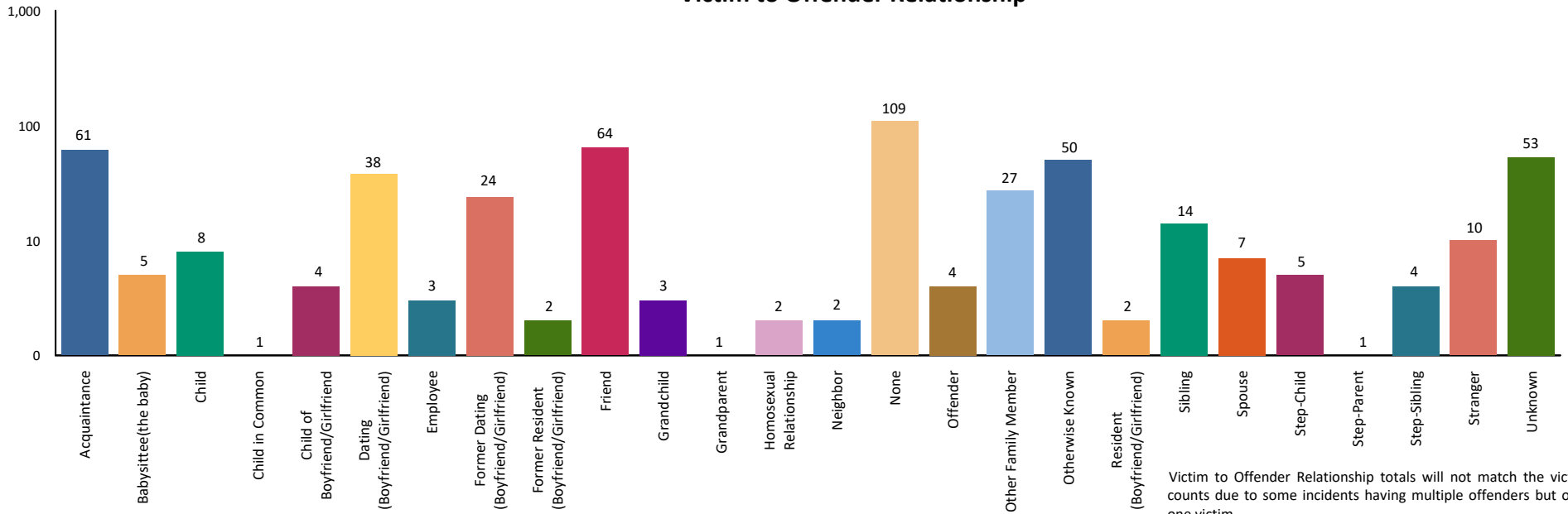

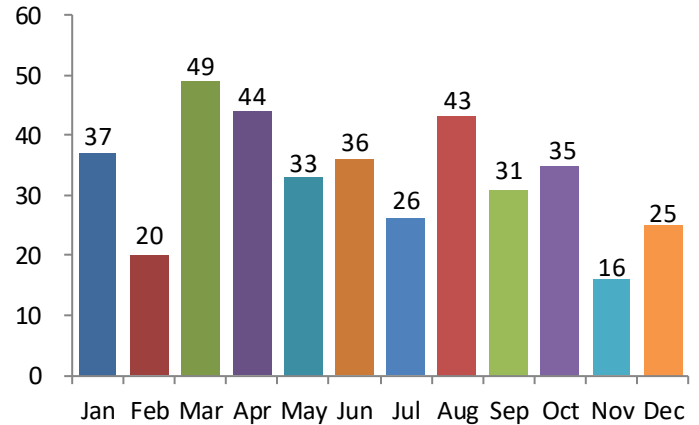

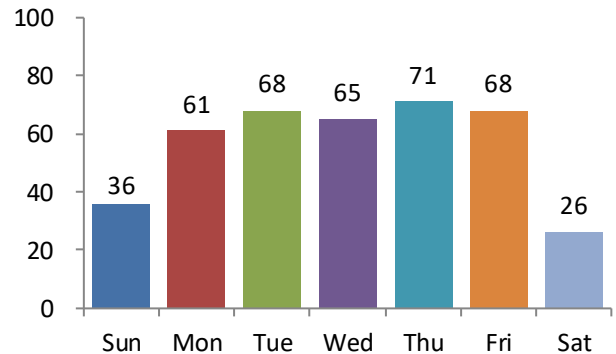

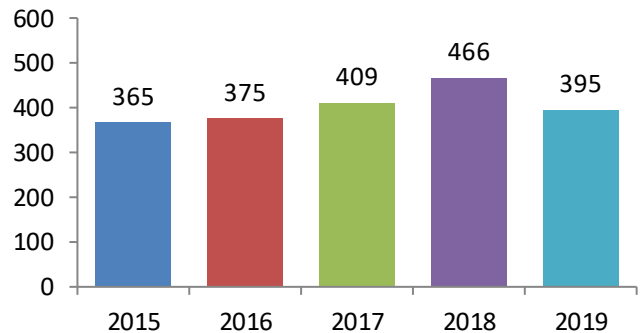

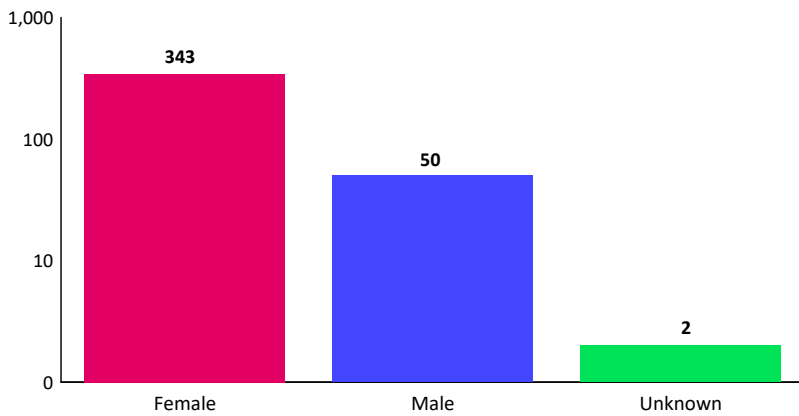

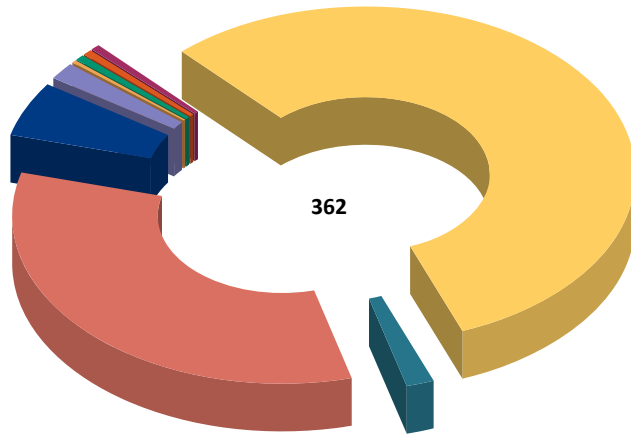

Location of Crime



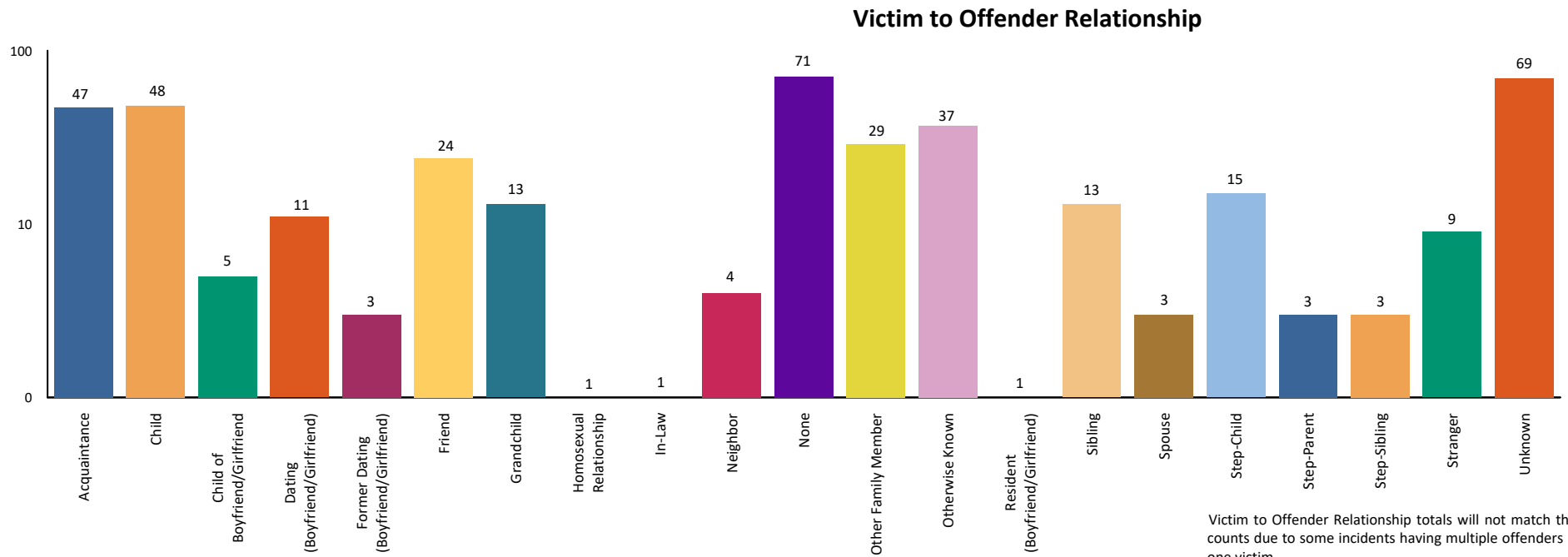

Criminal Sexual Conduct (CSC) 3rd Degree (MCL 750.520d) is *the sexual penetration of a person, forcibly and/or against that person's will; or, not forcibly or against the person's will where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity.* Michigan collects the crime data for this offense based on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Incident Based Reporting System.

Note: CSC 1st and 3rd Degree are differentiated by the weapon involved and the degree of the victim injury. CSC 2nd and 4th Degree (forcible contact) are not included in the Rape category per the Federal Bureau Uniform Crime Reporting Program.

ANALYSIS

VOLUME

The number of victims reported for CSC - 3rd Degree, Sexual Penetration-Object was 221. This is a reported increase of three percent from 2018 and a 24 percent increase from 2015.

More victims were reported in the month of January than any other month. The largest number of victims were reported on Thursdays.

RATE

The crime rate for this offense in 2019 was two for every 100,000 persons, which is the same rate that was reported in 2018.

CLEARANCES

Law enforcement agencies cleared 51 incidents by an arrest or exceptional clearance out of the 212 incidents that were reported. This is a reported 24 percent clearance rate.

VICTIM INFORMATION

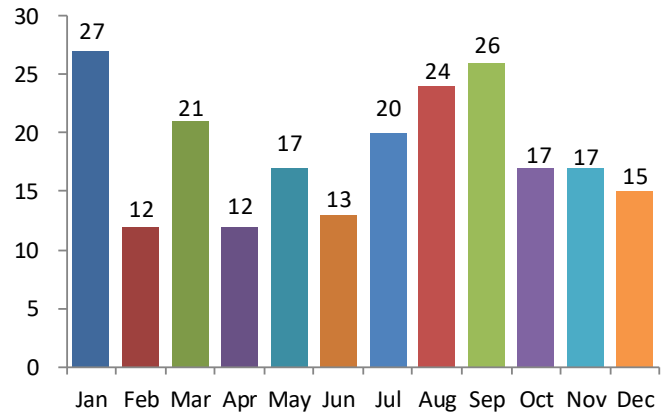
Eighty-seven percent of the victims did not receive any injury. There were eight percent of victims who received Apparent Minor injuries and four percent received Possible Internal injuries.

Sixty-two percent of the victims did not have a weapon used against them. The most used weapon, occurring 31 percent of the time, was Personal Weapons (e.g., hands, fists, feet, etc.).

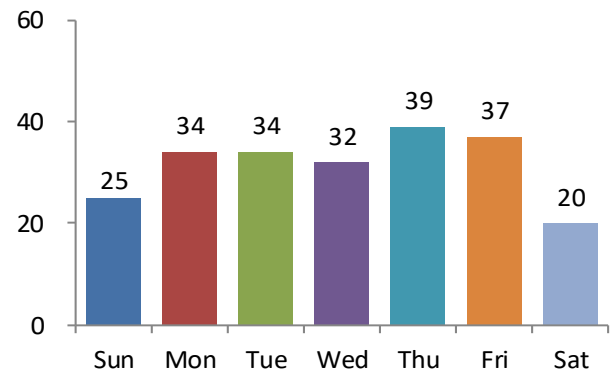
In 16 percent of the relationships, the victim was an Acquaintance of the offender. In 12 percent of the relationships, the victim was a Friend of the offender.

The most reported location was a Residence/Home, which equates to 68 percent of the incidents.

Victims by Month

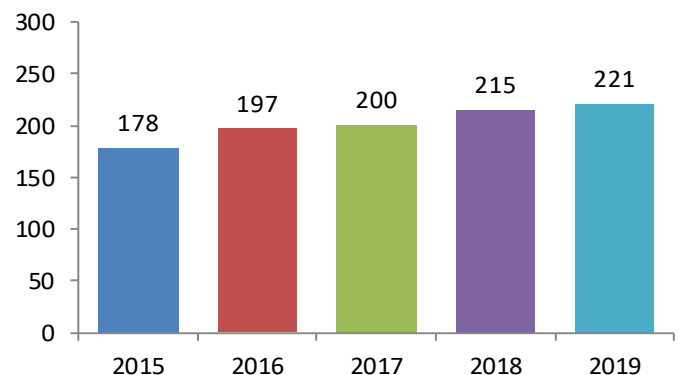


Victims by Day

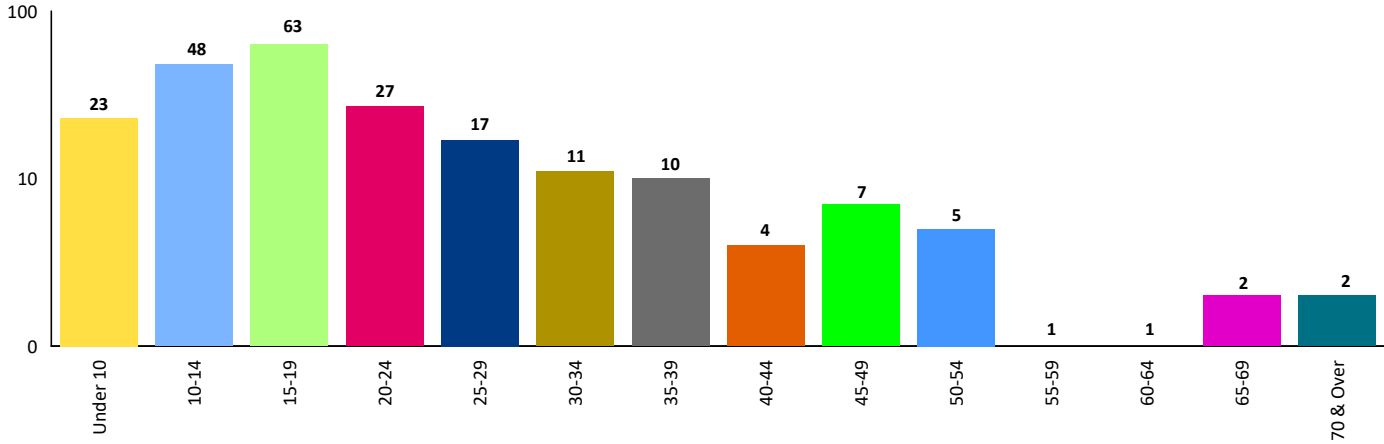


5-Year Trend

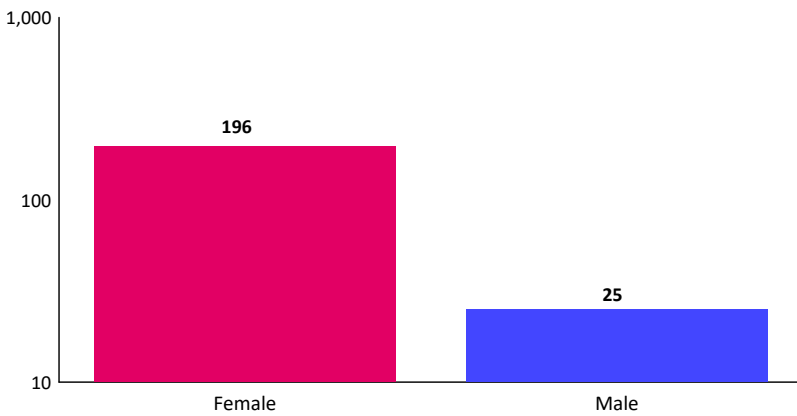
Number of Victims

Twenty-nine percent of the victims were between the ages 15 and 19.

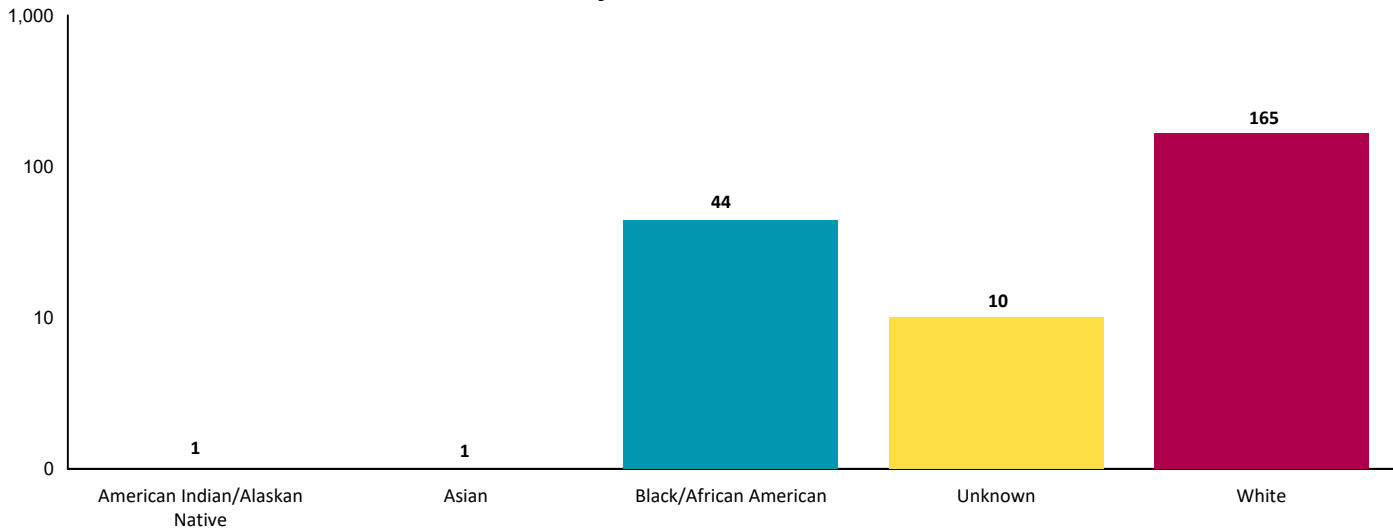
Gender Analysis

Race Analysis

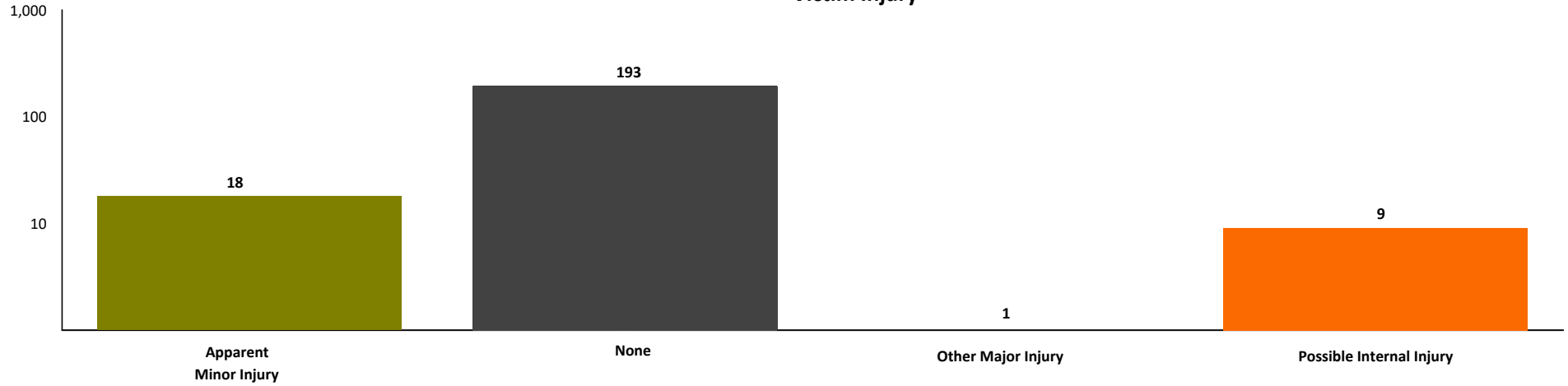
Seventy-five percent of the victims were White and 20 percent were Black/African American.

Race of Victims

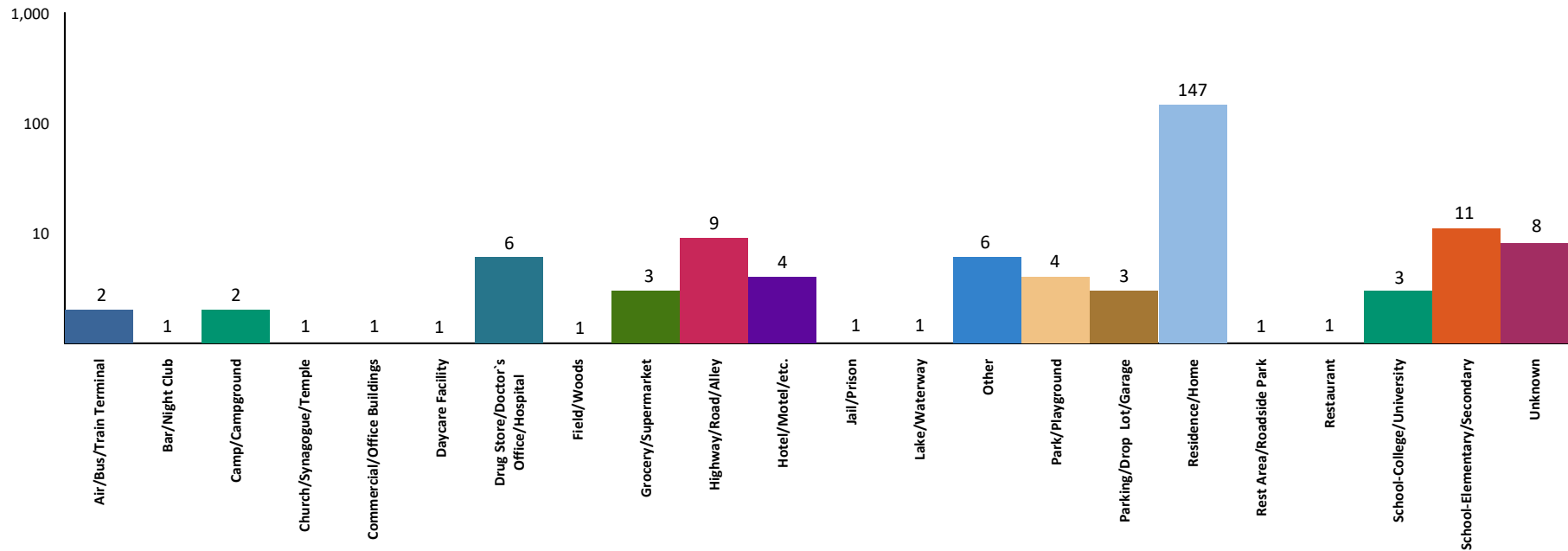


2019 CSC - 3rd Degree Sexual Penetration-Object

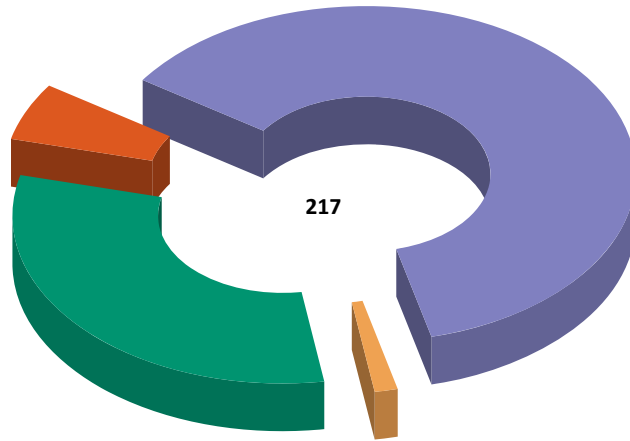
Victim Injury

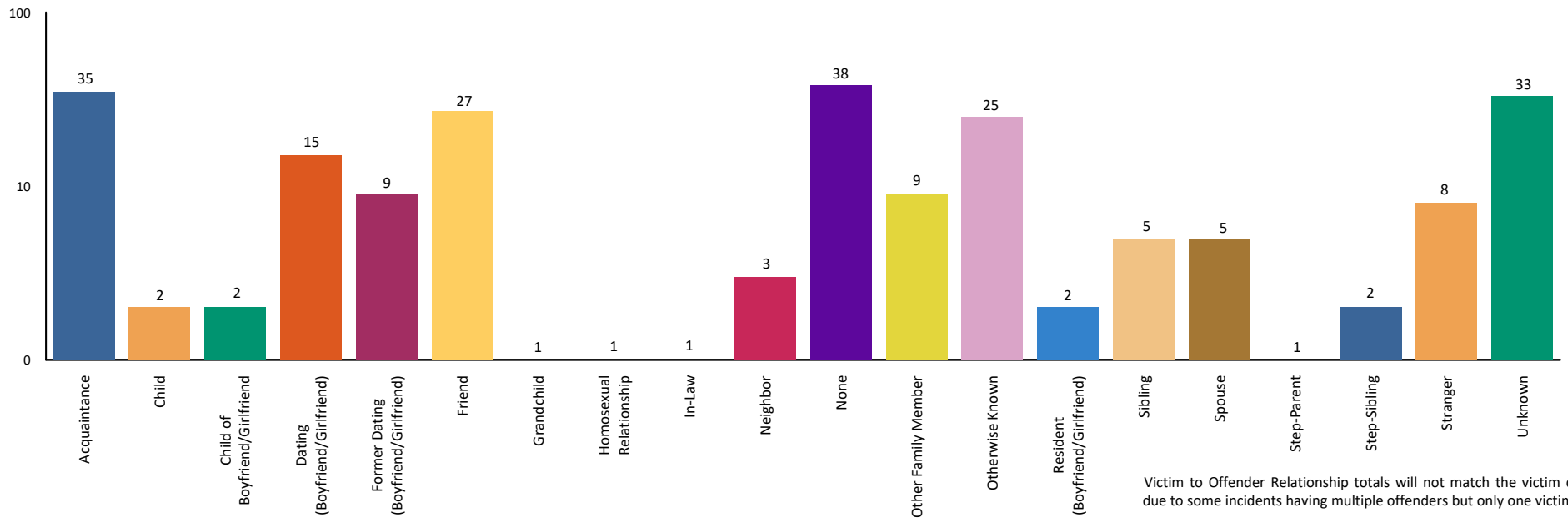
